# OPERATING REVENUES, EXPENSES \& STATISTICS <br> RAILWAYS IN CANADA WITH ANNUAL OPERATING REVENUES OF \$500,000 OR OVER 

FOR TAE HONTH OF JUNE, 1940.



Freight traffic of Cunadian railwaye in Juse measured in revenue ton miles was the heeviest for the month to date exceeding 1939 trafflc by 93 per cont and 1929 traffic by 21 per oent. The average revenue par ton mile mes only 0.791 oent, as against 1.080 cents in jure 1928 , and oonsequently freight revenues were less than in 1929 but greater than any other June since 1930.

Tatal gross revenues of $\$ 36,913,950$ were also greater than for any other June since 1930. The inorease over 1539 revenues was $\$ 10,753,544$ or 41.1 per oent for the total, $\$ 8,983,958$ or 48 per oent for fraight and $\$ 1,774,214$ or 152 per cent for express. The express revenue was not oxly the largest Jume revenue earned but also was larger than for any othor month to date.

Opereting expenses inorpesed over 1939 by $\$ 3,260,654$ or 13 per cent and the operating income was incremsed by $\$ 7,056,856$ or fram $\$ 600,609$ to $\$ 7,657,475$.

For the first half of the year grosa revenues inoreased from $\$ 153,180,846$ in 1939 to $192,100,813$ and the operting inocme increased fran $\$ 3,139,443$ to $\$ 26,472,980$.

CAMADLAN NATIONAL RAILHAYS: GTOSs revenues of CAnadian lines Inoremsed by 52.7 per oent, or from $\$ 12,833,873$ in 1839 to $\$ 19,597,675$. Operating expenses inoresed fram $\$ 13,176,660$ to $\$ 14,609,12$ and the operating income fram a debit of $\$ 721,585$ to a oreait of $\$ 4,575,549$.

Freight traffic measured in ton miles increased by 95 per oent and passenger miles inoreased by 14.6 per oent over 1939 June traffic. All four lines ir the United States showed larger grose revenues and opersting inoones incronsing the systeris grose revenues fram $\$ 15,189,521$ in 1939 to $\$ 22,359,957$ and the operating income from a debit of $\$ 689,371$ to a oredit of $\$ 4,823,228$.

For January - Jume system grass revenues ware $\$ 113,681,561$ as agalnat $\$ 87,681,530$ in 1939 and the operating inocme incresed by $\$ 16,523,175$ or from a debit of $\$ 4,568,047$ to a oredit of $\$ 11,955,128$.

CAMADIAN PACIFIC RAILMAY COMPANY, FTeight trafilic wes more than twioe herry es in June 1939, but rreight revenues inoressed only $\$ 3,820,670$ or 53 per cent. Totial revenues inoressed to $\$ 14,253,546$ fran $10,464,234$. Operatiag expenses increased by $\$ 1,635,824$ and the operating inocme increased from $\{1,063,318$ to $\{2,223,055$.

For Junuary - June gross revenues ware $\$ 75,641,753$ as against $\$ 62,331,796$, and the operating incane was $\$ 12,636,008$ as against $\$ 5,351,345$ in 1939.
