Canadian railways earned $\$ 41,886,809$ in April es against $\$ 29,915,744$ in April 1940. With the exceptlons of 1928 and 1929 this was the highest April earnings of the railways and was more then trios the April 1955 revenue. Freight revemse was 59 pec. above April 2940 revenue and passenger revenue was up by $65 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{c}$. Operating expenses increased frow $425,568,848$ in 1940 to $\$ 30,179,663$ and the operating income was increased from $\$ 5,076,819$ to $\$ 9,125,160$. Due to an increase in the average passenger journey from 77.1 to 117.0 miles, passenger miles increased by 81.4 pec. for an increase in the number of passengers carried of 19.6 pec. Total pay roll increased from $\$ 16,259,586$ to $\$ 18,101,353$ or by 21.5 pec. for an increase in the muir of enployeen of 10,465 or 8.6 pec.

For Jamary - April gross revenues increased from $\$ 120,557,222$ in 1940 to $\$ 153,252,275$ and the operative income from $\$ 12,055,725$ to $\delta 25,848,584$.

CANALIAK NAIIONAL FATLYAYS: Gross reveres of Cenedian Ines increased by 45.8 pec. or frow $614,696,519$ in April 1940 to $\$ 21,136,921$ and the operating income increased from 8669,084 to $\$ 5,316,084$. Two of the United States lines showed improvements over last year ls operations and two showed decreases. The system gross revenues increased frow $\$ 17,686,164$ to $\&<4,448$, eg h ur k, ils aerating income increased from $\$ 1,004,835$ to \$5,972,599.

For January - April system gross revenues were $389,347,566$ in 1941 and $871,040,279$ in 1940 and the operating income wee $\$ 14,076,950$ es egeingt $\$ 4,311,242$ in 1940 .

CAMADIAN PACIFIC LALLhAY COMPANY: Gross revenues amounted to $\$ 16,71$, 786 as against $812,089,282$ in 1940 and the operating income increased from $\$ 1,946,080$ to $\$ 3,149,265$. The evergge freight haul was increased frow 455.8 to 519.3 miles and the average passenger journey from 84.6 to 225.7 wiles.

Hor January - April gross revenues inereasec from $547,857,38$ : In 1940 to $265,407,288$ and the peretinf income frow $\$ 7,248,569$ to $\$ 11,669,571$.
