

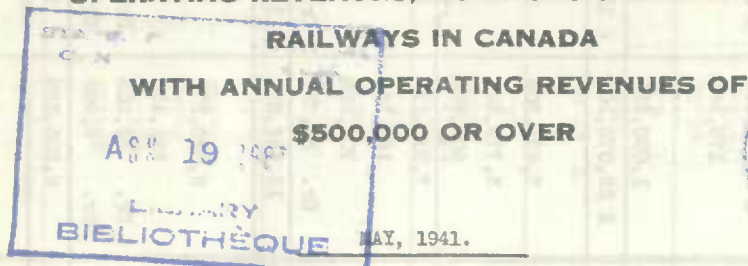

**OPERATING REVENUES, EXPENSES & STATISTICS**



Gross revenues of Canadian railways for May amounted to \$46,594,656, the highest May revenues on record and an increase of \$11,965,015 or 34.6 p.c. over May 1940 revenues. Operating expenses were greater than in 1940 by \$4,954,734 and the operating income increased from \$5,759,782 to \$11,067,583 or by \$5,307,801.

Tons of revenue freight carried amounted to 11,061,918 as against the previous May record of 11,031,912 tons carried in May 1929, and the revenue ton miles amounted to 4,386,613,000 as against 3,046,564,000 made in May 1928, an increase of 44 p.c. over the previous May record. The number of passengers carried increased from 1,334,227 in May 1940 to 1,603,204, but this was less than half the number carried in May 1922 and 1923.

The total pay roll increased from \$17,609,596 in 1940 to \$19,649,446 for an increase in the number of employees from 131,286 to 143,099.

For January - May gross revenues increased from \$155,186,863 in 1940 to \$199,826,929 and the operating income from \$18,815,505 to \$36,916,187.

CANADIAN NATIONAL RAILWAYS: Gross revenues of Canadian lines increased by 32.8 p.c. or from \$17,377,796 in May 1940 to \$23,073,108, and with operating expenses up by 12.9 p.c. the operating income increased from \$2,450,348 to \$6,203,629.

For the system, gross revenues increased from \$20,261,335 to \$26,725,770 and the operating income from \$2,810,657 to \$6,915,011.

For January - May system gross revenues were \$116,073,136 in 1941 and \$91,321,614 in 1940 and the operating income increased from \$7,121,899 to \$20,991,960.

CANADIAN PACIFIC RAILWAY COMPANY: Gross revenues increased from \$13,550,825 in May 1940 to \$19,343,617 or by 42.7 p.c., and the operating income increased from \$2,464,384 to \$4,181,819. Freight traffic measured in ton miles increased by 65.8 p.c. Passenger traffic also increased by 26.4 p.c. in the number carried and 59.1 p.c. in passenger miles.

For January - May gross revenues increased from \$61,388,207 in 1940 to \$81,750,905 and the operating income increased from \$9,712,953 to \$15,851,390.
