**OPERATING REVENUES, EXPENSES & STATISTICS
RAILWAYS IN CANADA
WITH ANNUAL OPERATING REVENUES OF
\$500,000 OR OVER**

AUGUST, 1941.



Canadian railways earned \$46,523,645 during August as against \$37,408,735 in August 1940. With the exceptions of 1928 and 1929 this is the largest August revenue earned. Operating expenses amounted to \$35,988,263, an increase of \$5,748,266 over expenses in 1940, and the operating income increased from \$5,166,490 to \$7,593,163. Tons of revenue freight carried increased over 1940 by 22.6 p.c., and revenue ton miles established a new record for the month at 4,323,275,000 which was 44.7 p.c. above August 1940 ton miles. Passenger traffic measured in passenger miles was 42.7 p.c. above passenger traffic in 1940; the average journey increased from 124.2 miles to 150.4 miles. Total pay roll amounted to \$21,420,331 for 149,676 employees compared with \$18,188,150 for 135,270 employees in 1940. The peak railway employment was in August 1928 with 190,894 employees and \$24,843,298 pay roll.

For January - August gross revenues increased from \$267,907,091 in 1940 to \$336,609,515 and the operating income from \$37,681,485 to \$61,547,372.

CANADIAN NATIONAL RAILWAYS: Gross revenues of the Canadian lines increased from \$18,443,497 in August 1940 to \$22,327,370, operating expenses increased from \$15,350,097 to \$18,196,786 and the operating income increased from \$2,658,540 to \$5,617,499. All four lines in the United States showed increases over 1940 in gross revenues and operating incomes, raising the system gross revenues from \$21,220,188 in 1940 to \$25,808,928 and the system operating income from \$2,882,491 to \$4,212,768.

For January - August system gross revenues increased from \$157,296,771 in 1940 to \$193,179,858 and the operating income increased from \$18,206,494 to \$35,211,444

CANADIAN PACIFIC RAILWAY COMPANY: Gross revenues were increased from \$15,583,602 in August 1940 to \$20,037,443 and the operating income increased from \$2,263,597 to \$3,146,005. Freight traffic was heavier than in 1940 by 48.0 p.c., and passenger traffic increased by 32.9 p.c.

For January - August gross revenues increased from \$106,608,344 to \$139,763,486 and the operating income from \$17,304,456 to \$28,261,118.
