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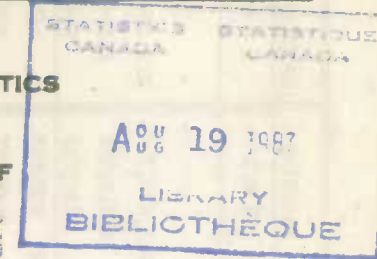

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**OPERATING REVENUES, EXPENSES & STATISTICS  
RAILWAYS IN CANADA  
WITH ANNUAL OPERATING REVENUES OF  
\$500,000 OR OVER**



MARCH, 1942

Canadian railways created new records in March with higher gross revenues, operating expenses, freight traffic and passenger traffic than in any previous March, and the freight traffic, measured in revenue ton miles, has been exceeded only in November 1927 and October and November 1928. Gross operating revenues amounted to \$50,857,695 as compared with \$40,812,525 in March 1941. Operating expenses increased from \$30,940,590 in 1941 to \$37,357,524, and the operating income increased from \$7,312,807 to \$10,086,517. Freight traffic was heavier than in March 1941 by 14.5 p.c., and passenger traffic was heavier by 48.5 p.c. The pay roll increased from \$17,829,928 to \$21,885,711 or by 22.7 p.c., for an increase in the number of employees from 128,754 to 159,667 or of 8.5 p.c.

For the first quarter gross revenues amounted to \$140,523,861 as against \$111,345,464 in 1941, operating expenses increased from \$88,722,217 to \$107,729,711 and the operating income from \$16,725,424 to \$25,871,029.

CANADIAN NATIONAL RAILWAYS: Gross revenues of Canadian lines increased from \$19,805,472 in March 1941 to \$25,264,000 or by 27.6 p.c. Operating expenses increased from \$16,109,606 to \$19,498,684, and the operating income increased from \$3,251,092 to \$5,149,790. The United States lines showed a decrease in revenues and an increase in expenses, making the system gross revenues \$28,706,000 as against \$25,528,006, and the operating income \$5,390,898 as against \$4,052,723 in 1941.

For the first three months system gross revenues increased from \$64,698,467 in 1941 to \$79,625,000 and the operating income increased from \$8,104,550 to \$12,320,589, all of this latter increase being on the Canadian lines.

CANADIAN PACIFIC RAILWAY COMPANY: Gross operating revenues increased from \$16,702,406 in March 1941 to \$20,854,598 or by 25 p.c. Operating expenses increased by 22 p.c., and the operating income increased from \$3,246,075 to \$5,785,955. Freight traffic increased by 9.9 p.c., and passenger traffic by 50.3 p.c.

For January - March gross revenues increased from \$45,695,502 in 1941 to \$57,992,965, and the operating income from \$8,520,406 to \$9,984,011.

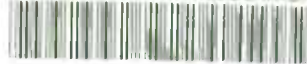
