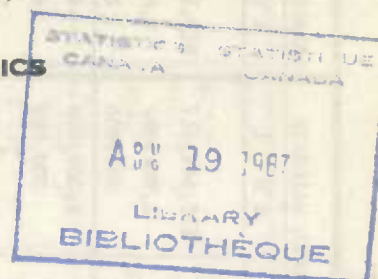

OPERATING REVENUES, EXPENSES & STATISTICS

RAILWAYS IN CANADA

WITH ANNUAL OPERATING REVENUES OF
\$500,000 OR OVERJULY, 1942.

Canadian railways earned \$57,529,040 during July, which was by far the highest July revenue on record and has been exceeded only by the revenue of October 1928 when \$61,871,000 was earned. The increase over July 1941 revenue was \$12,087,104 or 26.6 p.c. Freight traffic measured in revenue tons carried and in ton miles was the heaviest July traffic and was exceeded only by October and November, 1928. Although the number of passengers carried was less than for July and August, 1922 and 1923, the average journey was longer and the revenue passenger miles reached an all-time monthly peak at 511,468,000. Operating expenses increased from \$35,248,142 in 1941 to \$42,004,198 and the operating income from \$7,261,680 to \$10,581,519. The pay roll was increased from \$20,989,616 to \$24,162,507 or by 15.1 p.c., for an increase of 4.7 p.c. in the number of employees which stood at 156,145 for July.

For January - July gross revenues increased from \$290,085,868 in 1941 to \$558,751,904 and the operating income from \$54,154,210 to \$67,961,636.

CANADIAN NATIONAL RAILWAYS: Gross revenues of Canadian lines increased from \$22,005,664 in 1941 to \$29,287,800 or by 33.1 p.c. Operating expenses were increased by 25.3 p.c. and the operating income was increased from \$3,374,609 to \$5,802,505. The United States lines showed increases in both gross revenues and operating incomes raising the system revenue from \$25,655,442 for July last year to \$55,153,000 and the operating income from \$4,055,656 to \$6,652,566.

For January - July system revenues increased from \$167,370,930 to \$202,548,000 and the operating income from \$30,998,676 to \$38,493,598, the increases being all on the Canadian lines.

CANADIAN PACIFIC RAILWAY COMPANY: Gross revenues increased from \$19,582,782 in July 1941 to \$22,128,951 or by 14.2 p.c. Operating expenses were increased by 9.4 p.c., and the operating income was increased from \$3,195,420 to \$3,268,451.

For January - July gross revenues increased from \$119,726,043 in 1941 to \$144,012,890 and the operating income from \$23,115,113 to \$25,216,554.
