## OPERATING REVENUES, EXPENSES A STATISTICS Rallways in camada WITH ANNUAL OPERATING REVENUES OF \$500,000 OR OVER

Canadian railwaje arned $\$ 64,366,068$ in May as againet $\$ 55,055,500$ in May lagt year. Operating expenses ware increased from $\$ 57,606,343$ to $\$ 46,656,267$, and the operating income increased from $111,510,550$ to $\$ 12,445,267$. Frelght traflic was heavier than $1 n 1942$ by 11.8 par cont and passongur tralfic fncreased by 34.6 per cont, amounting to a daily average of 385 passenger milea par mile of road and to 148 par passenger train mile. This waw o high average train loading. Bak in 1920 whon pasaongor traffic was the heaviest prior to 1948 the average passongers per trein nover reschad 100 ; trains ware aborter thea averaging 7 to 8 cars asainst an avarage of 10.5 in May. The average journey was 120 miles as aguinat 109 miles in May 1942 and 71 miles for 1980.

For January - My operating revenues increased $\operatorname{srom} \$ 243,956,358$ in 1942 to $\$ 296,229,557$, and the operating income increased from $\$ 45,684,022$ to $848,604,952$.

CANADIAN NATIONAL RAILTATS: Operating revanues ware increased to $\$ 52,977,200$ Irom $\$ 26,386,100$ in May last year. Oparating expenses were increased by $95,969,011$, and the operating incon was increased from $\$ 6,328,207$ to $\$ 6,709,758$. Freight trafilc was hoavier than 181942 by 16 per cant and peasenger traffic inoreased by 44 per cent. The average numbar of passengers par triain (weighted by niles) wan increased from 116 to 159. The United States lines showed increases in groas revenuea and operating inoce raileing the systam operating revanu to $\$ 37,075,000$ as againet $\$ 29,687,000181942$ and the operating inocm to 87,187,446 from $6,672,825$.

For January - May eystem operating revenues were increased froa $\$ 157,626,000$ in 1842 to $\$ 171,2 z 4,000$ and the opereting income was increased from $424,955,590$ to $288,867,487$.

CAMNIAN PACIFIC RAILMAI COMPANI: Oparating revenues were increased by 18.4 per ceat or from $\$ 21,704,751$ in May 1942 to $\$ 24,395,251$. Oparating expenses ware inareased by $\$ 2,422,430$ and the opereting income was increased from $\$ 4,255,561$ to $\$ 4,513,415$. Freight traffio showed only a sall increase but pessenger traffic increased by 23 per cent.

For January - My operating revames samuted to $412,250,954$ as ageinst $100,460,055$ in 1942 and the operating income amounted to $116,781,725$ as against $17,773,719$.
