



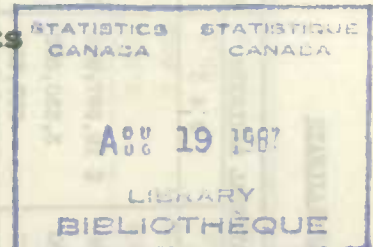

**OPERATING REVENUES, EXPENSES & STATISTICS
RAILWAYS IN CANADA
WITH ANNUAL OPERATING REVENUES OF
\$500,000 OR OVER**

FEBRUARY, 1944.



Canadian railways earned \$59,630,307 in February as compared with \$53,024,504 in February, 1943. This was an increase of 12.5 per cent. The extra day in February, 1944 would account for an increase of 3 to 4 per cent for items of revenues, expenses, traffic, wages, etc., which are not accrued, earned or paid on a monthly basis.

Operating expenses increased by \$5,522,116 or 13.2 per cent and the operating income increased from \$7,238,843 to \$8,510,971. Freight traffic measured in revenue ton miles increased by 12.7 per cent and passenger miles increased by 15.6 per cent. The number of employees increased from 155,851 to 159,887 or by 2.6 per cent for an increase in the pay roll of \$1,802,991 or 7.5 per cent. The extra day would increase wages of employees on hourly and daily rates without a corresponding increase in the number.

For January - February gross revenues increased from \$103,703,981 in 1943 to \$118,749,547 and operating income increased from \$13,429,171 to \$15,992,254.

CANADIAN NATIONAL RAILWAYS: Operating revenues of Canadian lines increased by 11.7 per cent from \$26,612,100 in 1943 to \$29,726,400. Operating expenses increased by \$2,604,619 or 11.8 per cent and the operating income increased from \$3,283,395 to \$4,127,694. The United States lines showed an increase in gross revenues but a decrease in operating income. The system gross revenue increased from \$30,329,000 to \$33,874,000 and the operating income increased from \$3,925,745 to \$4,621,985.

For January - February system operating revenues increased from \$59,607,000 in 1943 to \$66,970,000 and the operating income increased from \$7,306,970 to \$8,655,689.

CANADIAN PACIFIC RAILWAY COMPANY: Operating revenues increased from \$20,517,852 to \$23,862,500 or by 16.3 per cent. Operating expenses increased by \$2,719,225 or 17.3 per cent and the operating income increased from \$2,819,368 to \$5,039,652. Freight traffic was heavier than in 1943 by 20.0 per cent and passenger traffic increased by 19.2 per cent. The average freight haul increased from 454 to 471 miles and the average passenger journey from 120 to 136 miles.

For January - February operating revenues increased from \$39,559,313 in 1943 to \$47,932,383 and the operating income from \$8,346,660 to \$10,684,638.
