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# OPERATING REVENUES, EXPENSES \& STATISTICS RAILWAYS IN CANADA WITH ANNUAL OPERATING REVENUES OF \$500,000 OR OVER 

JANUARY, 1946

Canadian railways earned $\$ 55,796,577$ during January as compared 1 with $\$ 58,388,550$ in January, 1945. Freight revenues declined by $\$ 2,269,470$ or 5.3 per cent, and passenger revenues by $\$ 349,514$ or 5.8 per cent for decreases in revenue ton miles of 2.2 per cent, and in passenger miles of 10.0 per cent. Operating expenses were increased from $\$ 50,758,561$ to $\$ 52,637,332$ or by 5.7 per cent, and the operating income was reduced from $\$ 4,687,065$ to $\$ 135,087$. The total pay roll was reduced from $\$ 29,973,729$ to $\$ 29,770,660$ or by $\$ 208,069$, for an increase in the number of employees from 167,621 to $\mathbf{1 6 8 , 5 9 1 \text { . The }}$ average haul for freight was reduced from 383 to 378 miles, but the average passenger journey was increased from 100 to 121 miles and, when the commuter traffic is excluded, frow 118 to 122 miles. The average freight receipt per ton mile was reduced from 0.902 contr to 0.874 cents, and the passenger receipt per passenger mile was increased from 1.949 to 2.083 cents or, excluding commuter traffic, from 1.995 to 2.085 cents.

CANADIAN NATIOXAL RALLWAIS: Operating revenues of Canadian lines declined from $\mathbf{\$ 2 8 , 5 4 6 , 4 0 0}$ In January, 1945, to $\$ 27,317,700$, or by 4.3 per cent. Freight revenues declined by $\$ 953,900$ or 4.7 per cent, and passenger reveres by $\$ 282,300$ or 6.4 per cent. Operating expenses were reduced by $\$ 126,398$, and the operating income was reduced from $\$ 2,724,662$ to $\$ 1,567,516$. Revenues of the United States lines declined from $\$ 4,021,600$ to $\$ 3,583,500$, and for the system from $\$ 52,568,000$ to $\$ 50,901,000$, and the operating income of the United States lines declined from a credit of \$223,240 to a debit of \$250,117, and the system operating income was reduced from $\$ 2,947,902$ to $\$ 1,317,899$.

CANADIAN PACIFIC RAILWAY COMPANI: Operating revenues amounted to $\$ 23,47,804$ es compered with $\$ 24,234,515$ in 1945. Freight revenues declined by $\$ 884,220$ or 4.9 per cent, but passenger revenues increased by $\$ 111,608$ or 2.9 per cent. Operating expenses ware reduced by $\$ 342,515$ or 1.6 per cent, and the operating income was reduced from $\$ 1,661,878$ to $\$ 1,218,412$, tares increasing by $\$ 4,867$, and hire of equipment by $\$ 29,390$. Freight ton miles declined by 3.3 per cent, and passenger miles increased by 2.1 per cent due to an increase in the average journey from 136 to 146 wiles.
