Operating revenues in August were $\$ 61,689,715$, compered with $666,785,994$ in 1945 , a decline of 7.6 per cent, comp red with 15.3 per cent in July. Operating menses increased from $\mathbf{5} 5,434,410$ to $\$ 55,601,961$ in 1946 , leaving not operating revenue of $\$ 6,087,754$, compared with $\$ 13,349,584$ in August, 1945. The expenses for the month included retroactive wage increases amounting to $\mathbf{~} 2,614,997$.

CAMADIAN RATIONAL RAILFAYS: Operating revenues of Canadian line only in August totalled $\$ 30,608,400$ against $\$ 53,953,200$ last year, while expenses increased from $\$ 26,454,094$ to $\mathbf{\$ 2 8 , 2 6 9 , 1 5 6 .}$ The increase in expenses was accounted for by retroactive wage increases. After taxes, and equipment and joint facility rents the operating income was $\$ 1,820,354$, compared with $\$ 7,009,591$ in August, 1945 .

CABADIAN PACIFIC BAILHAY COMPANIB Operating revenues in August were $\$ 25,406,850$, compared With $\$ 26,972,507$ in the same month last year. Operating expenses ware slightly higher at $\$ 22,874,218$ against $\$ 22,662,505$ in 2945. The operating income after taxes, and equipment and joint facility rents was $\$ 720,329$, compared with 8816,364 in August, 1945.
