RAHLYAYS IN CANADA

## WITH ANNUAL OPERATING REVENUES OF

\$500,000 OR OVER

OCTOBER, 1948

Canadian railways aerned a record $\$ 82,839,900$ from operations during October compared with the previous monthly high of $\$ 79,481,743$ in September and $\$ 69,820,158$ in the preceding October, representing increases of 4,2 p.o. and 18.8 p.c., respectively. Gotobar is normally the most active month of the railmay year. Fralght revenuan improved $\$ 12,516,659$ or by 22.5 pec . to $\$ 68,587,004$, whough car loadinge increased but fractionally. Frelght ernings ware mors than double October, 1950, when the total was $133,167,647$. Passanger account showed a minor docresse from the sase month of 1947, mifle wail and express revomues adrancod, expreas F1sing by 480,084 or 18.7 p.c. to $\$ 5,046,791$ for the month - a nem peak.

Operating expenses were alao on the upgrade, cllibing rrou $\$ 58,675,819$ in October, 1947, to $\$ 69,655,066$, sn increase of $18.7 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{c}$. or $\$ 10,979,247$. A11 axpenditure accoumte were hesvier ith maintenance up $\$ 4,867,170$ to


Wet operating rovenue showed a gain of $+2,040,495$ over the ememonth of 1947 at $\$ 18,184,854$, but inoreased taxes and hire of equipment chargee reduced this total to an operating incom of 19,864 , 303 compared with $\$ 8,427,989$ one yoar earlier. While the tonnage of revenus ireight transported wae down slightif from the prevlous
 cente to 1.161 cents. The aumber of revenue passengers declined 116,945 but the length of the average journey facessed from 94 to 96 miles. Passenger train mileage was up $1 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{c}$., and ampty frelght car miles rose $\mathrm{B} .6 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{C}$. against an increse of $1.7 \mathrm{p}, \mathrm{c}$. in loeded milage.

Total pay rall for 181,191 employeas reaohed $\$ 42,668,781$ during the month and included $\$ 443,488$ of retroactive pey. This represents a rise of over $\$ 7,070,000$ Without backtime compared with October, 1947. Pey roll chargesble to railway operating expenses advanced from $\$ 52,72,677$ to $\$ 59,729,433$ inciuding the back pay while the miller of euployoes mes up 7,000 or $4 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{C}$

7or the f1ret ten monthe of 1948 all rallway had operating revenues of $\$ 708,315,212$ against \$641,294,172 one ywer sarlier, whil. supanses roge from $\$ 588,966,145$ to $\$ 660,648,220$. Operating income consequentiv declined from $\$ 38,546,526$ to $\$ 16,524,096$ - far from eurficient to meet intarest orligation whiah aggregatod over $466,000,000$ for the year 1947.

GATADIAN HAIIOAAL RANWAIS: The Canadian linee reported reverues of $\$ 40,454,500$ for the month, up $\$ 7,395,100$ or 22.4 p.c. over the previous October with an 1mprovement of $\$ 6,992,000$ ar $26,8 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{c}$. in freight earning . Passanger account was up $\$ 91,900$ or by $5.5 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{c}$., and appress advanced by $\$ 322,052$ ar 18 p.c. over Octobor, 1047. Operating expenses kept pace with armings, increasing 22.5 p.c. or $\% \% 6,690,554$ to $\$ 56,418,863$. Maintenance costs ware up ovar $\$ 5,022,000$ and traneportation rose $\$ 5,428,255$ to $\$ 18,828,335$. Het operating revenuee totalled $4,035,437$ and ware reduced by heavier tax and hire of equipaent cborges, reaulting in an operating income of $\$ 5,065,601$ againet $\$ 2,781,164$ one ywar earliar. The American lines of the syetem ghowed rwvanues of $\$ 6,455,700$ and oxpenses of $\$ 4,837,137$, while operating income netted $\$ 1,069,356$ to give an operating income of $\% 4,138,937$ for the entire ayvtam during 0ctober. In the ten month sumary a oredit of $\$ 4,311,274$ in operating income from United States lines belps to offset the deficit of $\$ 4,695,00$ for the Canadian divisioma, leaving a not deblt of $\$ 385,728$.

CMADIAB PACIFIC RAILIAT COMPARI: An increse of $\$ 4,439,455$ or 14.7 wa shom in October earninge of the company as compered with the total of $\{80,013,528$ credited in the sam month of $194 \%$. Of this suprovamsat $\$ 4,294,307$ appear undar frelght revanue wioh rose froin \$24,621,727 to \$28,918,024 or by 17.4 p.0. Passanger revemuer declined slighty and exprese mes op 12.9 p, c. or by 33,942 tram the previous October. Operating - penses ware $\$ 5,822,988$ or 16.1 p.c. heavier at $\$ 27,497,076$ as against $\$ 23,674,088$. Malntenance expendituree increased $\$ 1,884,880$ and traneportation charges $\$ 1,957,045$ to $\$ 13,705,356$. Tax acaruale and equipment rental. advanced, and operating income revealad a gain of $\$ 460,226$ at $\$ 5,671,587$ for the month under review. Tomage of rovemue freight carried increased by less then 1 p. 0. or 42,256 tons, but freight mileage decilned iractionally. There were 45,078 fawer paseoxgere carried an ooppard with the previous Ootober and avarage journoy wae unchanged. Pay roll statistics showd 68,724 emioyes reowifing $\$ 16,509,222$ against 65,484 on staff earning $115,709,140$ in October, 1947. Rallway operatione ware charged with $\$ 15,851,470$ and $\$ 12,911,082$ reapectively. In the period Jamury - October, total operating revmnues for the Canedien Pacilie Rallway Company were e90,059,997 against
 in the seave perlod of $194 \%$.
