OPERATING REVENUES, EXPENSES & STATISTICS RAILWAYS IN CANADA WITH ANNUAL OPERATING REVENUES OF \$500,000 OR OVER

DECEMBER, 1948

Canadian railways reported operating revenues of \$77,483,355 during December, an increase of \$8,852,381 or 12.9 p.c. over the same month of 1947 and \$15,557,000 above December, 1946. The current revenues were a new high for any December. Operating expenses, however increased more rapidly jumping from \$58,349,893 to \$72,522,817 up \$14,172,924 or 24.3 p.c. above December, 1947. Net operating revenue was consequently reduced from \$10,281,079 in 1947 to \$4,960,536 in the month under review. With a considerable easing in tax accruals, operating income suffered only a minor decline from \$6,904,417 to \$6,836,085. A credit of \$3,153,834 is shown in the December tax accrual account to adjust over-charges during the previous eleven months.

All revenue accounts except passenger and water line improved over December 1947. Freight revenues increased \$8,013,640 or 15.1 p.c. to \$61,042,287, express was up \$437,796 or 14.9 p.c. at \$3,385,135 and miscellaneous or 'all other' revenue increased \$479,547 to \$5,773,936. Every expense account was appreciably higher, with maintenance of way and structures up \$1,278,171, maintenance of equipment advancing \$7,542,329 to \$17,457,829 or by some 76 p.c., and transportation expenses at \$36,426,618 for the month rose \$4,131,896 or by 12.8 p.c.

Debits for hire of equipment and joint rents were up some \$104,639 over Becember, 1947. Operating statistics reveal a drop of 509,025 tons in the volume of revenue freight carried compared with the previous December, the totals being 13,846,949 tons and 14,355,974 tons respectively. Mileage carried decreased by 4.2 p.c. while tonnage was off 3.5 p.c. Revenue passengers totalled 3,120,840 as against 3,380,652, a %7 p.c. recession while passenger mileage eased 4.2. p.c. from the preceding December.

Total payroll for December was nearly #41,400,000 up 18 p.c. or \$6,328,864 while the number of employees rose from 173,102 to 177,075 or by 2.3 p.c. The portion of payroll chargeable to railway operations increased \$5,069,939 or 15.4 p.c. to \$38,071,884.

CANADIAN NATIONAL RAILWAYS: Canadian lines of the system showed a gain of 19.6 p.c. in revenues over December 1947, the total of \$39,492,683 for the month increasing \$6,485,588 to a new high for any December. Operating expenses rose \$4,086,264 to \$34,289,326 up 13.6 p.c. and the net operating revenue consequently improved from \$2,804,033 to \$5,203,357 or by nearly \$2,400,000. Tax accruals were reduced some \$122,884 to \$572,498 but joint rents increased. Operating income stood at \$4,346,515 for the month against \$1,934,614 a year earlier, a gain of \$2,411,901. Freight revenues improved \$5,424,838 to \$30,435,317 or 21.7 p.c. despite a decrease of 5.5 p.c. in tons carried or a 2.0 p.c. drop in ton mileage. Passenger revenue, mail and express accounts were higher. Maintenance of way and structures expenses were reduced one quarter or \$1,829,921 but maintenance of equipment rose 68 p.c. or \$2,761,088 over December, 1947. All other expense accounts increased with transportation charges up \$2,295,867 or 13.3 p.c. to \$19,581,924. Total monthly payroll reached \$22,717,976 compared with \$19,009,033 one year earlier and employees increased 2,855 to 99,680. American lines of the system reported revenues of \$5,527,267 and operating expenses of \$4,527,644 with net operating revenues of \$999,623 as against \$946,340 in December of 1947. Combined operating income for both Canadian and U.S. lines was \$4,845,822 compared with \$2,167,737 one year previous.

CANADIAN PACIFIC RAILWAY COMPANY: Revenues indicated a gain of 7.7 p.c. or \$2,229,908 over December, 1947 totalling \$31,077,318 but operating expenses showed a much greater advance jumping \$9,245,192 to \$32,845,993, a rise of over 39 p.c. Maintenance charges were heavy increasing \$7,346,372 to \$16,183,100 while transportation expenses were up 12.7 p.c. or \$1,596,689. Net operating revenue for the month showed a deficite of \$1,768,675 but tax accordal adjustments at the year end claimed a credit of \$3,911,918, so that operating income was \$1,883,166 as against \$3,923,301 in December, 1947.

Tons of revenue freight at 5,063,866 were down 132,400 tons or 2.5 p.c. while ton mileage decreased 5.9 p.c. Revenue passengers declined 53,879 to 1,246,743 for the month. Total payroll was \$16,184,990 against \$13,866,166 in the preceding December up 16.7 p.c. while employees numbered 67,489 an increase of 980 or 1.5. p.c. The ratio of operating payroll to operating revenues was 49.2 p.c. against 45.7 p.c. one year earlier.
