## RAILWAYS IN CANADA

# WITH ANNUAL OPERATING REVENUES OF 

## \$500,000 OR OVER

JUNE 1948

Bernings of Canadian rail ways in Jume ware $\$ 68,745,419$ compared with $\$ 71,000,817$ in May and $\$ 65,515,450$ in June last year, for an 1acrease of 5.3 p.C. Pright revenuer improved from $\$ 49,490,315$ one year ago to $\$ 55,642,594$ or by B. 4 p.c., but passenger reveaues ware off $\$ 961,000$ from Juna, 1947 , docinining from $\$ 8,318,855$ to $\$ 7,357,800$ or by 11.6 p.c. Ebparess revenuas adwanced nearly $\$ 290,000$ to $\$ 2,872,011$ and mail roee to $\$ 704,684$, up $\$ 35,600$ 。

Contrasting with the increase of $\$ 3,430,000$ in earnings, operating axpanses jumped $\$ 15,397,000$ or by 23.3 p.c. to $\$ 70,807,527$ - by far the highest for any month in railway history - and include provision for the rotrosctive portion of recent wage awards. This total compares wilth oxpenses of only $\$ 24,295,951$ in Jume, 1989. Maintenance accounte incresged by $6,957,650$ over Jume, 1947, to $\$ 31,845,475$, while trenoportation expenses 工ose froa $\$ 27,204,425$ to $\$ 52,733,542$ or by 20.3 p.c. Tax accruals, however, eased from $\$ 1,855,548$ to $\$ 189,732$ for the month dus to a credit of soeve $\$ 793,000$ on C. P.R. account. Hire of equipment receded $\$ 439,000$ to $\$ 1,001,818$.

The net operating income consequemtly ahowed a deficit of $\overline{6}, 421,562$ for the month compared with a credit of $\$ 4,458,848$ in Jume, 1947, and $\$ 4,337,445$ in May of this year.

The number of tons of revenue freight carried per freight trein mile decilined from 769 tons in June, 1947, to 680 tons, but roveme averaged $\$ 8.71$ per mile against $\$ 7.47$ one year earlier.

Passengers carmed par passanger train mile dropped from 95 to 86 wh th avarago journey at 10 ? wiles against 114 in $J u n e$ last. Avarage Ireight receipt per revenue ton ifle was 1.280 cente against 0.972 centa one year previous. The ratio of operating pay roll to operating revenues was 50.3 p.c. against 48.4 p.c. while expenses oxceeded revenues by 3 p.c.

Thare was an everage of 180,622 rallway mployees recelving a pey roll of $\$ 55,615,974$ during the month, axclusive of rotroectite pay, compared with 175,477 oaring $\$ 35,707,243$ in Jume of 1947. Pay roll chargeable to rallway operations rose 9.3 p.c.
111. railways reported revmues of $\$ 398,858,283$ in the first half of 1948 , an fmprovemant of $427,067,000$, mile axpenses rose $\$ 38,835,775$ to $\$ 573,859,215$. Operating income consequentiy declined from $16,975,765$ for the 8 monthe of 1947 to $\$ 7,021,758$.

CANADIAN NATTOAAT, BATLMATS; Canadian lines of the system sarned $\$ 85,951,000$ in Jume, up 5 p.c. or $\$ 1,609,500$ over the same month of lest yeer. Prelght revonues lnareased $\$ 1,725,000$ or 7.1 p. $c$. . While passenger accoumt dropped $\$ 294,500$ to $\$ 5,462,700$. Operating appanses adwanced by 14,2 p.c. to $\$ 55,24,161$ or by $\$ 4,096,56$ ? W th maintenance up $\$ 2,174,000$ and transportation $\$ 1,638,912$. A credit of $\$ 2,117,018$ in operating income for Jume, 1947, contrated with a debit of $\$ 131,919$ for the month woder review. The U. S. IInen, however, enjoyed a more prosperves month with revamues of $\$ 5,777,000$ and mpensea of $\$ 4,819,858$. The not result for the ntire system was operating income of $\$ 657,479$ against $\$ 2,568,140$ one year previous.

The half year reading for 211 lines ahome sarainge of $\$ 228,464,000$ againet axpenses of $\$ 217,358,000$ and a aet oparating incom of $\$ 2,642,916$ compered with $\$ 8,903,204$ in the first six months of 1947 .

CANADTAN PACTPTC PAITFAY COMPANY: A m-1nor increase of $\$ 767,589$ to $\$ 27,546,064$ in operating revenues wae recorded compared with a sharp adrance of $18,694,958$ in expenses, which robe neariy 87 p.c. over the previous Jume to $\$ 52,254,951$ - a new poak for the company - and includes rotroactive wage awards. Froight ournings improved 6.8 p.c. or $\$ 1,570,521$ but passenger recolpts ware down $\$ 596,957$ or by 15 p.c. Maintenance expenditures were very beary st $\$ 14,891,500$, Increasing $\$ 4,587,000$ over Jume, 1347. Traneportation charges Increased from $\$ 10,560,050$ to 614,249,960 or by some $55 \mathrm{p}, \mathrm{c}$. Despita a tax credit of $\$ 792,924$, oparating income ragiatared a debit of $\$ 4,206,959$ for the month against a credit of $\$ 1,768,600$ one fear anclier. Average longth of haul of revamu fralght was 579 miles against 450 whil average passenger journey was 121 compared with 155 miles in Jume, 1947. Froight recelpte averaged 1.255 cente per ton 111 againet .907 conts.

The six month comparison shows a dobit of $\$ 163,603$ on oparating incose ageinst a crodit of $\$ 6,421,922$ to the and of Juna last Jear. Bevenued increased $\$ 8,848,000$ to $\$ 160,829,880$, wh1 operating expeases were up $117,870,000$ at $\$ 154,567,280$.
