### OPERATING REVENUES, EXPENSES & STATISTICS RAILWAYS IN CANADA WITH ANNUAL OPERATING REVENUES OF

#### SEPTEMBER, 1953

September operating revenues advanced \$3,991,542 or 4.0 p.c. to \$102,617,478 for the month compared with \$98,625,936 in September, 1952. Freight revenues gained 5.7 p.c. or \$2,882,847 to \$81,759,990; passenger revenues were up 4.4 p.c. to \$7,784,804; mail revenues rose 15.6 p.c. to \$1,253,200; water line revenues were up 11.4 p.c. to \$551,500 and miscellaneous revenues up 19 p.c. to \$5,602,452. Express and other passenger train revenues were down 5.1 p.c. and 8.1 p.c. respectively to \$4,574,352 and \$1,071,180.

Operating expenses outstripped revenue gains by increasing 11.0 p.c. from \$82,777,531 to \$91,897,289.

Maintenance of way and structures up 21.9 p.c. or \$3,604,931 to \$20,075,885; maintenance of equipment up \$1,950,569 to \$20,872,926 and transportation, \$2,532,250 higher at \$42,227,003 accounted for much of the increase which, however, was common to all groups.

Net operating revenue fell by \$5,128,216 to \$10,720,189 for the month. Tax accruals were \$2,964,167 lower at \$2,825,108 and this together with slight improvements in hire of equipment and joint facilities rents out the decrease in operating income to \$2.043,777. Operating income during September totalled \$6,955,352.

Freight traffic was reduced in volume with tonnage carried 2.8 p.c. lower at 15,065,102 tons and tom miles down 2.7 p.c. to 5,246,379,000 ton miles. Passengers carried numbered 9,970 fewer at 2,382,939 but average journeys were longer and passenger miles climbed 4.8 p.c. to 268,785,000 passenger miles. While the number employed increased by less than one percent to 206,350 employees the earnings of railway personnel rose by 11.2 p.c. to \$57,961,600.

CANADIAN NATIONAL RAILWAYS: All revenue accounts of this company showed improvement with the exception of "other passenger train" which fell 10.7 p.c. to \$498,286. Freight revenues gained \$1,478,000 to \$41,682,000 and "other" revenues rose by \$633,792 or 20.6 p.c. to \$3,711,315. Total revenues were up 5.1 p.c. or \$2,622,300 to \$53,906,000.

Operating expenses were 11.1 p.c. higher at \$50,272,375 with maintenance of way and structures up 24.7 p.c. to \$10,607,957, maintenance of equipment 10.3 p.c. greater at \$11,504,689, miscellaneous operations 20.4 p.c. more costly and general expenses 18.1 p.c. larger.

September net operating revenue was down \$2,389,107 to \$3,633,625 but small improvements occurred in accrued taxes, hire of equipment and joint facilities rents accounts. The operating income of the system's Canadian Lines was \$3,122,165, some \$2,130,452 lower than one year previously.

Average operating expenses per train mile rose from \$7.90 one year ago to \$8.41 in September. Train miles operated in both freight and passenger services were greater than in September, 1952. Passengers carried and passenger miles were also up slightly but freight traffic was down some 5.1 p.c. in tonnage of revenue freight carried and 3.1 p.c. in ton miles.

CANADIAN PACIFIC RAILWAY COMPANY: Operating revenues of the C.P.R. rose by \$253,647 to \$39,326,680 for the current September. A 27.5 p.c., \$358,905 drop in express revenues to \$944,323 and a small decline in "other passenger train" revenues offset much of the gains in the other revenue accounts. The rise in operating expenses was 11.1 p.c. or \$3,496,826 and featured 20.3 p.c. higher maintenance of way and structures, 11.7 p.c. greater maintenance of equipment and 17.6 p.c. more general costs. Total operating expenses for the month were \$34,946,978. Not operating revenues of \$4,379,702 were \$3,243,179 lower than the not of \$7,622,881 im September, 1952. Tax accruals were \$2,810,000 lower and smaller gains in hire of equipment and joint facilities reats brought the operating income to \$2,783,471, some \$323,279 below the previous September.

Passenger travel was improved with longer passenger journeys accounting for a 4.1 p.c. increase in passenger miles with virtually no change in passengers carried. Tons of revenue freight carried were down 1.2 p.c. and revenue ton miles were 4.3 p.c. lower at 2,182,056,000 ton miles. Employees numbered 75,976, down slightly from the 76,468 one year previously, but their earnings were up almost 10 p.c. from \$19,571,313 to \$21,489,780.
