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## RAILWAY OPERATING STATISTICS

(Operating Revenues, Expenses and Statistics of 16 Railways mainly with Annual Operating Revenues over \$500,000)

February revenues of the sixteen railways which report monthly operating statistics totalled \$84,084,555, down 6.7 p.c. from the \$90,158,496 earned in February, 1955. Operating expenses were 4.2 p.c. lower at \$82,774,461 compared with \$86,385,004 twelve months previously. Improved balances of tax accruals, equipment rentals and joint facilities rentals, held the loss in operating income to \$1,404,503. Operating income registered a net debit of \$2,103,275 compared with a debit of \$698,772 in February, 1953.

Freight revenues at \$69,213,064 were off 7.6 p.c. and express, other passenger train and "other" revenues were lower. Passenger, mail and water line revenues improved over Pebruary, 1953. All expense accounts except the "general" group took larger amounts than previously with "transportation" and "maintenance of equipment" up "1,725,104 and \$1,420,420 to \$39,143,360 and \$20,040,244 respectively.

Revenue freight carried was reduced 7.9 p.c. at 11,535,409 tons but, due to a drop in the average haul, from 404 to 589 miles occasioned in part by a greatly reduced movement of grain, the revenue ton mileage performed was 11.2 p.c. lower at 4,492,488,000 ton miles. Passengers carried were up slightly from 2,211,678 to 2,266,066 persons and the total passenger miles gained from 188,510,000 to 190,780,000. Loaded freight car miles were down 7.7 p.c. at 162,817,827 miles and empty freight car miles fell 6.0 p.c. to 76,581,741 indicating a slightly higher ratio of empty to loaded cars in trains. Pay-roll was \$1,983,958 lower at \$50,180,671 a drop of 5.8 p.c. while employment was off 4.7 p.c. or 9,208 persons to 185,101. The ratio of operating payroll to operating revenues rose from 55.8 p.c. to 55.5 p.c. and of operating expenses to operating revenues from 95.84 p.c. to 98.44 p.c.

CANADIAN HATIONAL RAILWAYS: Revenues on the Canadian lines were 5.0 p.c. or \$2,315,900 lower at \$44,165,000. A 5.3 p.c., \$2,005,000 drop in freight revenues accounted for most of the loss in revenues. Lower expenses, especially on transportation accounts, brought the total expenses down 5.3 p.c. to \$46,957,548. Operating loss for the month was almost \$600,000 greater being up from debit of \$2,517,740 to a debit of \$3,117,261.

Tomage was off 8.3 p.c. at 5,000,765 tons and total freight haul was 11.0 p.c. lower at 2,290,970,000 ton miles. The 1,303,017 passengers carried was only slightly above February, 1953 feres but longer journeys brought a 5.5 p.c. gain in passenger miles at 88,776,000.

Net operating income of \$564,754 on the United States lines of the C.N.R. reduced the System loss for the month to a deficit of \$2,552,527 compared with a \$1,836,591 deficit in February, 1953.

CANADIAN PACIFIC RAILWAY COMPANY: Operations in February resulted in revenues of \$32,282,547, down 8.1 p.c. from February, 1953. Freight revenues were down 9.7 p.c. or \$2,925,279 to \$27,176,489. Expenses at \$30,276,142 were 4.9 p.c. lower the improvement being mainly in maintenance of way and structures and of equipment. Tax accruals were \$470,000 lower and, together with more favourable balances on joint facility rentals and equipment hire, held the reduction in operating income to \$543,708. Operating income for the month was \$373,129.

Average length of haul of freight carried by the company was down from 497 to 455 miles and this is evident in the 12.6 p.o. drop in ton miles compared with a 4.5 p.o. fall in tonnage carried. The average passenger journey was also shorter being 108 miles as compared with 117 one year previously. Passengers carried at 778,917 were 9.0 p.o. higher but passenger miles gained less than  $\frac{1}{8}$  of one percent to 83,902,000 for the month. The average freight revenue per ton mile for the C.P.R. was 1.476 cents against 1.429 cents in February, 1953. Passenger receipts per passenger mile gained from 2.626 cents to 2.838 cents in the interval.
