# RAILWAY OPERATING STATISTICS 

(Opernting Revenues, Expenses and Statistics of 16 Rallways mainly with Annual Operating Revenues over $\$ 500,000$ )

Fobruary revenues of the sixteen railway whioh report monthly opersting statistio totelled $\mathbf{8 8 4 , 0 8 4 , 5 6 5 ,}$ domn 6.7 p.C. fra the $190,158,486$ eerned in February, 1955. Operating expenves wore 4.2 p.c. Jower at $\$ 82,774,461$
 facilities rentalin, bild the loss in operating incone to $\$ 1,404,503$. Operating income registered a not debit of \$2,105,275 compared with debit of $\$ 698,772$ in February, 1955.

Froight revenues et $\$ 69,213,064$ were off 7.6 p .0 . and exprepm, other paseanger traln and other revenues wert lower. Passenger, ail and weter line revenuen improved over Fobruary, 1953. All oxpenso acoounts except the "goneral group took Iesper mounts than proviouly with "transportation ind "mintenmoo of equipent" up 1 , 725,104 and $11,420,420$ to $\$ 38,145,360$ and $\$ 20,040,244$ respectively.

Reveme frelght onrried wes reduoed 7.9 p.o. at $11,535,409$ ton but, due to a drop in the averege haul, fram 404 to 589 miles ocomsloned in pert by a grently reduoed movement of grain, the rovenue ton wileage performed was 11.2

 A5. 5 p.o., $12,005,000$ drop in freight revenues cooounted for most of the loss in revomuse Lower expenses, espeolally on transportation iocountw, brought the total expenses down $5.3 \mathrm{p} \cdot 0$. to $946,957,548$. Operating lose for the month wes almont $\$ 600,000$ greater being up from debit of $\$ 2,517,740$ to a debit of $\% 5,117,261$.

 4.9 p.o. lower the improvement being minaly in maintenence of why and struotures and of equipment. Tex socrule were $\$ 40,000$ lower and, together with more favourable balanoe on joint facility rentala and equipment hire, held the res duction in operating income to 1543,708 . Operating incame for the month wes $373,128$.
