RAILWAY OPERATING STATISTICS

(Operating Revenues, Expenses and Statistics of 17 Railways mainly with Annual Operating Revenues over \$500,000)

TOTAL - 17 RAILWAYS:

Operating revenues of 17 railways amounted to \$82,833,461 for January, 1955, up 5.81 p.c. from \$78,283,505 for the 16 railways reporting for January,1954; freight revenues increased by \$4,819,794 to \$66,832,250 but passenger revenues dropped by \$418,884 to \$5,778,047. Operating expenses dropped 2.0 p.c. to \$80,247,-547 from \$81,877,858 with maintenance of equipment reduced by \$806,000 to \$18,952,811 and transportation costs down by \$1,316,291 to \$39,754,556. (On the basis of 16 railways reporting for both 1954 and 1955, revenues rose 5.77 p.c. and expenses declined 2.9 p.c.). Net operating revenue amounted to \$2,585,914 versus a loss of \$3,594,353 a year ago. Heavy tax accruals of \$3,377,192 caused a net operating deficit of \$826,488 for January, 1955. This compares with a deficit of \$5,644,582 in January, 1954. Revenue freight carried increased 10.4 p.c. to 12,489,546 tons from 11,308,994 and freight ton miles increased to 5,064,026,000 from 4,309,340,000. Passengers carried, however, dropped 1.5 p.c. to 2,376,673 from 2,412,973 and passenger miles fell to 200,477,000 from 211,811,000. There were 177,049 employees on payrolls, down 4.5 p.c. from 185,386 with earnings dropping to \$47,118,806 from \$48,901,338.

CANADIAN NATIONAL RAILWAYS:

Canadian Lines: - Revenues increased 2.5 p.c. to \$41,471,000 from \$40,-440,400 but expenses dropped 5.1 p.c. to \$42,989,116 from \$45,300,275 leaving a net operating loss of \$1,518,116 versus a loss of \$4,859,875 in 1954.

The System including United States Lines: - Operating revenues increased 2.6 p.c. to \$47,749,000 from \$46,537,000 whereas operating expenses dropped 4.8 p.c. to \$48,122,000 from \$50,568,000 resulting in a net operating loss of \$373,000 as against a loss of \$4,031,000 in January,1954.

CANADIAN PACIFIC RAILWAY COMPANY:

Operating revenues amounted to \$33,350,725, up 10.3 p.c. from \$30,245,094 but operating expenses were cut 0.1 p.c. to \$30,990,402 from \$31,022,407. The result was a net revenue of \$2,360,323 for 1955 versus a loss of \$777,313 for 1954. Net income stood at \$485,866 versus a net deficit of \$1,294,798 in January, 1954. Revenue freight carried rose 12.2 p.c. to 4,467,435 tons but passengers carried declined 0.6 p.c. in number to 821,244.
