RAILWAY OPERATING STATISTICS

Historical File Copy

(Operating Revenues, Expenses and Statistics of 17 Railways mainly with Annual Operating Revenues over \$500,000)

TOTAL - 17 RAILWAYS:

Operating revenues for April, 1955 amounted to \$90,691,713 for 17 railways, up 2.48 p.c. from \$88,492,676 for 16 railways one year earlier. Operating expenses, however, dropped 2.48 p.c. to \$81,055,878 from \$83,113,618. This reduction was mainly due to a \$1 million decrease in maintenance of way and structures and maintenance of equipment. (On the basis of 16 railways for both 1954 and 1955 i.e. excluding the Quebec North Shore and Labrador Railway revenues increased 2.47 p.c. and expenses fell by 3.17 p.c.) Net operating revenue rose 80 p.c. to \$9,635,835 from \$5,379,058. Net railway operating income was greatly improved at \$5,314,757 as compared with \$1,573,267 for April 1954. Revenue freight carried during the month totalled 12,538,405 tons, up 8.2 p.c. from 11,589,655 while revenue freight ton miles increased 9.5 p.c. to 4,776,467,000 miles from 4,362,020,000 in 1954. Revenue passengers carried numbered 2,137,472, down 6.3 p.c. from 2,280,141 and revenue passenger miles declined 4.7 p.c. to 211,495,000 from 222,006,000. Fewer employees were on railway payrolls during the month being down 2.2 p.c. to 174,959 from 178,851 with their earnings down 1.2 p.c. from \$47,150,030 to \$46,582,645.

Changes in the accounting system of the Quebec North Shore and Labrador Railway require the revision of certain operating figures for the months of January, February and March 1955. Revised figures are provided in the table below.
