RAILWAY OPERATING STATISTICS

Historical File

DOMINION BUREAU

Included in the current report are the November financial and October operating statistics pertinent to railway activities in Canada. This is due to the fact that financial data is submitted on a more current basis than operational detail. Statistics of the Grand Falls Central Railway in Newfoundland were included in this series for the first time in 1957. However, commencing with the month of September, comparable details of the 1956 operations of this road have been provided.

Financial Statistics

Railway operating revenues of the twenty-two class 1 and 2 companies, (those averaging gross revenues of \$500,000 or more annually), totalled \$103,321,963 during November, down 6.5 per cent from \$110,547,332 in the previous year. Operating expenses declined to a lesser degree, dropping 2.7 per cent to \$97,438,751 from \$100,161,068 and the net railway operating income amounted to \$5,883,212 or 43.4 per cent less than the \$10,386,264 reported for the previous November.

A breakdown of financial details for the two major railways shows the Canadian National with operating revenues of \$48,424,070, expenses of \$48,063,601 and a net operating income of \$360,469. In comparison, operations for November 1956 produced revenues amounting to \$53,728,813, expenses totalling \$50,000,519 and a net of \$3,728,-294. The Canadian Pacific Railway Company reported revenues of \$41,910,169 during the current period, down from \$42,999,220. Expenses declined to an even greater degree, dropping to \$36,915,776 from \$38,694,435 resulting in a net operating income of \$4,-994,393 in contrast to \$4,304,785 a year earlier.

Rail operating revenues, which includes express, commercial communications and highway transport (rail) services as well as railway amounted to \$111,798,692 as compared with \$119,159,015 for the same month in 1956. Operating expenses declined to \$105,654,719 from \$108,110,858 as did the net rail operating income which amounted to \$6,143,973 in comparison with \$11,048,157.

Operating Statistics

The tonnage of revenue freight carried during the month of October declined to 19,236,567 from 20,684,012 as did the average miles hauled which fell slightly to 342 from 345. The number of ton-miles decreased to 6,574,008,000 from 7,144,933,000 and the average revenue per ton-mile of freight dropped to 1.446 cents from 1.459. Revenue passengers carried, numbered 1,761,755 during October, down from 1,960,464 and passenger-miles dropped to 190,149,000 from 206,018,000. However, the average passenger journey increased to 108 from 105 miles in the previous year and the average revenue earned per passenger per mile rose to 3.067 cents from 2.919.

The October operating ratio (expenses to revenues) increased to 92.63 per cent from 86.19.


