RAILWAY OPERATING STATISTICS

As financial statistics of railway operations are submitted on a more current basis than operating statistics it has become the practice to publish the financial section for each monthly period, one month ahead of the operating section. Consequently, financial data for March and operating data for February, 1957 are contained in this report. One class 2 railway, the Grand Falls Central in Newfoundland has been added in 1957 and does not appear in comparable figures for 1956.

Financial Statistics

Operating revenues of the 22 class 1 and 2 railways reporting for March 1957, totalled \$107,524,648, a rise of 6.0 per cent over the \$101,465,392 reported by 21 railwaysfor the same month of 1956. Operating expenses increased more rapidly than revenues, rising 8.2 per cent to \$101,526,153 from \$93,816,568 with the result that the net railway operating income dropped 21.6 per cent to \$5,998,495 from \$7,648,824.

The Canadian National Railways showed an increase in operating revenues to \$52,638,519 as compared with \$50,027,187 in 1956, and a higher increase in expenses to \$52,350,963 from \$47,247,632. The resulting net income dropped to \$287,556 from \$2,779,555. The Canadian Pacific Railway Company reported operating revenues of \$43,933,538, expenses amounting to \$38,704,565 and a net operating income of \$5,228,973 during the month. This compares with revenues of \$40,643,776, expenses totalling \$36,627,466 and a net operating income of \$4,016,310 during the same month of 1956.

Rail operating revenues, which includes railway, express, commercial communications and highway transport business classified as rail, amounted to \$115,594,405 for 22 railways as compared with \$109,171,028 for 21 railways in 1956. Operating expenses rose to \$109,254,003 from \$101,100,375 resulting in a decline in net operating income to \$6,340,402 from \$8,070,653 in the previous March.

Operating Statistics

Revenue freight carried by the 22 class 1 and 2 railways in February declined to 14,714,442 tons from 14,932,029 as did the average miles hauled which dropped to 386 from 392 one year earlier. Although ton-miles decreased to 5,678,500,000 from 5,853,159,000 the average revenue received for moving one ton one mile rose to 1.569 cents from 1.405. Fewer revenue passengers were carried during February, decreasing to 1,775,456 as compared with 2,179,619 in 1956. Although passenger miles declined to 182,057,000 from 184,830,000 the average receipt per passenger mile increased slightly to 2.949 cents from 2.900.

The ratio of total operating expenses to total operating revenues in February dropped slightly to 95.38 per cent from 95.65 per cent.
