### RAILWAY OPERATING STATISTICS

Historical File Copy

Presented in this report are the railway operating statistics for March and the financial statistics for April, 1957, covering the twenty-two reporting class 1 and 2 roads operating in Canada. As the financial data is submitted on a more current basis than operating data, it has become the practice to publish the financial portion a month ahead of the operating. One class 2 railway, the Grand Falls Central in Newfoundland, has been added in 1957 and does not appear in comparable figures presented for 1956.

#### Financial Statistics

Railway operating revenues of all reporting class 1 and 2 carriers in April amounted to \$104,849,188, up \$2,698,951 or 2.6 per cent from the \$102,150,237 realized by 21 railways during the like period of 1956. Operating expenses were held to an increase of 2.0 per cent, rising to \$99,540,564 from \$97,567,974 resulting in a net railway operating income of \$5,308,624 or 15.9 per cent more than the \$4,582,263 of April 1956.

The Canadian National Railways reported operating revenues of \$51,502,219 for the month of April in comparison with \$50,999,736 a year earlier, while expenses rose to \$49,171,335 from \$49,092,092. As a result, operations for the month produced a net operating income of \$2,330,884 in contrast to \$1,907,644 in 1956. The Canadian Pacific Railway Company show operating revenues of \$43,072,350 for April 1957, operating expenses totalling \$39,987,030 and a net railway operating income of \$3,085,320. This compares favourably with operating revenues of \$41,315,846, operating expenses of \$39,285,580 and a net of \$2,030,266 in the same month a year ago.

Rail operating revenues, which represent railway, express, commercial communications and highway transport (rail) services, amounted to \$113,402,268 for the twenty-two railways in April 1957. This compares with \$110,107,747 earned by twenty-one railways in the previous year. Rail operating expenses kept pace with revenues, rising to \$107,624,653 from \$105,034,647 with the effect that the net rail operating income rose to \$5,777,615 from \$5,073,100.

#### Operating Statistics

Operational statistics reveal that revenue freight carried in March, 1957, totalled 14,491,610 tons which developed 6,132,816,000 ton-miles for an average haul of 423 miles. This compares with 14,804,050 tons, 6,289,250,000 ton-miles and an average haul of 425 miles in March 1956. Revenue passengers numbered 1,913,201 in March 1957, down from 2,356,936, and passenger miles declined to 197,508,000 from 216,226,000. However, the average passenger journey rose to 103 miles from 92 in the previous year. The average receipt per ton-mile of freight rose to 1.525 cents from 1.392 while the average revenue per passenger per mile increased to 2.930 cents from 2.898.
