### RAILWAY OPERATING STATISTICS

As financial statistics of railway operations are submitted on a more current basis than operating statistics, it has become the practice to publish the financial section for each monthly period one month ahead of the operating section. Consequently, the June report includes June financial and May operating data. One class 2 railway, the Grand Falls Central in Newfoundland, has been added in 1957 and does not appear in comparable figures for 1956.

#### Financial Statistics

Railway operating revenues of the 22 class 1 and 2 carriers in June, 1957 dropped 2.4 per cent to \$108,786,859 from \$111,481,804 for 21 railways during the like period of 1956. Operating expenses rose 3.2 per cent to \$101,617,071 from \$98,508,201 and as a result net railway operating income declined 44.7 per cent to \$7,169,788 from \$12,973,603.

The Canadian National Railways showed a decrease in operating revenues to \$49,275,091 from \$52,309,439 while operating expenses rose to \$49,491,625 from \$46,064,-035. As a result, net operating income shows a deficit of \$216,534 compared with a profit of \$6,245,404 in 1956. The Canadian Pacific Railway Company reported an increase in revenues to \$44,343,037 from \$43,679,905, expenses \$39,409,143 from \$39,197,100 and a net operating income to \$4,933,894 from \$4,482,805.

Rail operating revenues, which include railway, express, commercial communication and highway transport (rail) services, amounted to \$117,333,634 as compared with \$120,037,218 for 21 railways in 1956. Operating expenses increased to \$109,884,677 from \$106,938,142 leaving a net rail operating income of \$7,448,957 from \$13,099,076 one year earlier.

#### Operating Statistics

Revenue freight carried by class 1 and 2 railways in June, 1957 totalled 16,967,680 tons which developed 6,043,557,000 ton-miles for an average haul of 356 miles. This compares with 18,017,768 tons, 6,630,398,000 ton-miles and an average haul of 368 miles in June 1956. Revenue passengers numbered 1,847,900 down from 2,012,428 while passenger-miles rose to 241,805,000 as compared with 225,696,000 for an average journey of 131 miles from 112 of the previous year. The average receipt per ton-mile of freight rose to 1.589 cents from 1.469 cents while the average revenue per passenger per mile changed only slightly to 2.947 cents from 2.946.

The ratio of operating expenses to operating revenues rose to 91.60 per cent from 88.63.
