RAILWAY OPERATING STATISTICS

The financial statistics of railways in Canada are submitted and published on a more current basis than operating data. Consequently, this report includes the November financial and October operating results of class 1 and 2 roads. One railway, the British Columbia Electric, has been added in 1958 and the comparable 1957 figures have been restated to include this company. As of January 1, 1958 the Hudson Bay Railway has been absorbed into the Canadian National System.

Financial Statistics

Railway operating revenues during the month of November declined 9.5 per cent to \$93,817,686 from \$103,650,098 for the same month of 1957. Operating expenses dropped 0.3 per cent to \$97,337,883 from \$97,670,338, resulting in a net operating loss of \$3,520,197 as compared with a surplus of \$5,979,760 in 1957.

The Canadian National Railways (including the Hudson Bay in 1958) reported a decline of 8.6 per cent in railway operating revenues to \$44,270,775 from \$48,424,070. Operating expenses, however, rose 11.9 per cent to \$53,778,690 from \$48,063,601 leaving a net operating loss of \$9,507,915 compared with a surplus of \$360,469 a year earlier. The Canadian Pacific Railway Company recorded a drop of 4.0 per cent in operating revenues to \$40,245,952 from \$41,910,169 and operating expenses fell 5.2 per cent to \$34,992,794 from \$36,915,776. The net operating income for the month rose 5.2 per cent to \$5,253,158 from \$4,994,393. The Canadian Pacific Railway Company results reflect provision for retroactive wage increases in the amount of \$400,000 for the month of November and a total of \$5.7 million for the eleven months of 1958.

Rail operating revenues, comprising railway, express, commercial communication and highway transport (rail) services amounted to \$103,035,697 as opposed to \$112,126,827 a year earlier. Operating expenses rose to \$106,214,672 from \$105,886,306 resulting in a net rail operating loss of \$3,178,975 from a surplus of \$6,240,521.

Operating Statistics

Revenue freight carried by railways during the month of October declined to 16,812,815 tons from 19,347,965, while the average miles hauled rose to 360 from 340. Although ton-miles decreased to 6,058,334,000 from 6,578,221,000 the average revenue received per ton-mile of freight increased to 1.487 cents from 1.450 cents. Fewer passengers were carried during the month, dropping to 1,668,012 from 1,761,755 in 1957. Passenger miles declined to 165,932,000 from 190,157,000 and the average journey was 99 miles in comparison with 108 in the previous year. The average revenue per passenger mile rose to 3.087 cents from 3.070.
