RAILWAY OPERATING STATISTICS

The financial statistics of railways operating in Canada are submitted and published on a more current basis than operating statistics. As a result, the current report includes March financial and February operating data. One railway, the British Columbia Electric, has been added as of January 1, 1958, while the Hudson Bay Railway has been absorbed into the Canadian National System.

Financial Statistics

Railway operating revenues of class 1 and 2 carriers during the month of March declined 12.8 per cent to \$93,934,173 from \$107,769,963 for the same month of 1957. Operating expenses fell 7.6 per cent to \$93,979,232 from \$101,745,118, resulting in a net operating loss of \$45,059 as compared to a surplus of \$6,024,845 in 1957.

Operating revenues of the Canadian National Railways (including the Hudson Bay) were lower at \$43,743,365 for the month of March, down 16.9 per cent from \$52,620,019. Operating expenses dropped 8.1 per cent to \$48,092,998 from \$52,333,666, and the net operating income declined to a deficit of \$4,349,633 as compared to a surplus of \$286,-353 for the like period one year earlier. The Canadian Pacific Railway Company reported operating revenues of \$41,753,650 as against \$43,933,538; operating expenses of \$36,-639,865 as compared with \$38,704,565 and a net operating income of \$5,113,785 as compared with \$5,228,973 in 1957.

Rail operating revenues, comprising railway, express, commercial communications and highway transport (rail) services amounted to \$101,982,433 as opposed to \$115,838,578 one year earlier. Operating expenses declined to \$101,592,842 from \$109,-490,930, while the net rail operating income dropped to \$389,591 from \$6,347,648.

Operating Statistics

The volume of revenue freight carried during the month of February 1958 declined to 11,749,214 tons from 14,814,683, while the average miles hauled rose to 408 from 383. The number of ton-miles decreased to 4,798,927,000 from 5,680,929,000 and the average revenue per ton-mile of freight dropped to 1.507 cents from 1.574. Revenue passengers carried numbered 1,764,269 during February, down from 1,845,053, and passenger-miles dropped to 155,017,000 from 182,057,000. While the length of the average passenger journey dropped to 88 from 99 miles the average revenue earned per passenger-mile rose to 3.068 cents from 2.953.

The February 1958 ratio of railway operating expenses to operating revenues increased to 107.85 per cent from 95.29.
