#### RAILWAY OPERATING STATISTICS

Financial details of railway operations in Canada are submitted and published on a more current basis than operating statistics. As a result, this report includes the June financial and May operating data. One railway, the British Columbia Electric, has been added as of January 1, 1958, while the Hudson Bay Railway has been absorbed into the Canadian National System.

#### Financial Statistics

Railway operating revenues of the twenty-two class 1 and 2 companies, (those averaging gross revenues of \$500,000 or more annually), totalled \$101,985,376 during June down 6.6 per cent from \$109,163,173 in the previous year. Operating expenses declined to a lessor degree, dropping 5.3 per cent to \$96,865,093 from \$102,292,536 leaving a net railway operating income of \$5,120,283 from \$6,870,637 in 1957.

A breakdown of financial details for the two major railways shows the Canadian National with operating revenues of \$48,178,616, expenses of \$48,766,223 and a net operating deficit of \$587,607. In comparison, operations for June 1957 produced revenues of \$49,275,091, expenses totalling \$49,491,625 and a net operating deficit of \$216,534. The Canadian Pacific Railway Company reported revenues of \$40,817,858 during the current period, down from \$44,343,037. Expenses declined also to \$37,099,203 from \$39,409,143 resulting in a net operating income of \$3,718,655 in contrast to \$4,933,894.

Rail operating revenues, which comprises railway, express, commercial communications, and highway transport (rail) services, amounted to \$110,725,199 as compared with \$117,709,948 for the same month of 1957. Operating expenses declined to \$105,236,-239 from \$110,560,142 as did the net rail operating income which amounted to \$5,488,960 in comparison with \$7,149,806.

#### Operating Statistics

The tonnage of revenue freight carried during the month of May declined to 15,025,088 from 17,080,129, while the average miles hauled rose to 400 from 354. The number of ton-miles decreased to 6,014,837,000 from 6,045,028,000 and the average revenue per ton-mile of freight fell to 1.461 cents from 1.596. Fewer revenue passengers were carried during the month, dropping to 1,622,176 from 1,848,371 in 1957. Passenger-miles fell to 196,009,000 in contrast to 241,907,000 for an average journey of 121 miles as against 131 miles in the previous year. The average revenue per passenger mile rose to 3.117 cents from 2.948.

The May 1958 ratio of railway operating expenses to operating revenues rose to 94.56 per cent from 91.60 in 1957.
