RAILWAY OPERATING STATISTICS

JANUARY 1959

As financial statistics of railways operating in Canada are submitted and published on a more current basis than operating data, it has become the practice to publish the financial section one month ahead of the operating. Consequently, the current report includes January 1959 financial and December 1958 operating results of class 1 and 2 roads.

Financial Statistics

Railway operating revenues during the month of January rose 1.8 per cent to \$89,690,399 from \$88,098,005 for the same month of 1958. Operating expenses increased 0.5 per cent to \$93,377,641 from \$92,935,627 resulting in a net operating loss of \$3,687,242 as compared with a loss of \$4,837,622 in 1958.

The Canadian National Railways reported an increase of 1.7 per cent in railway operating revenues to \$43,709,573 from \$42,978,000. Operating expenses, however, declined 0.9 per cent to \$47,761,235 from \$48,174,200 leaving a net operating deficit of \$4,051,662 as compared with one of \$5,196,200 a year earlier. The Canadian Pacific Railway Company reported an increase in operating revenues of 3.0 per cent to \$37,188,817 from \$36,115,350 while operating expenses rose 3.8 per cent to \$36,874,952 from \$35,536,994. As a result the net operating income fell to \$313,865 from \$578,356 in 1958.

Rail operating revenues, comprising railway, express, commercial communication and highway transport (rail) services amounted to \$97,514,899 as opposed to \$95,370,878 a year earlier. Operating expenses rose to \$100,855,869 from \$99,767,957 leaving a net rail operating deficit of \$3,340,970 as against one of \$4,397,079.

Operating Statistics

Revenue freight carried by railways during the month of December 1958 declined to 12,785,881 tons from 13,408,044, while the average miles hauled rose to 398 from 379. The number of ton-miles increased slightly to 5,084,971,000 from 5,080,031,000 and the average revenue per ton-mile of freight rose to 1.656 cents from 1.537. Revenue passengers carried numbered 1,985,157 during December, up from 1,928,241, and passenger miles rose to 239,588,000 from 231,868,000. While the length of the average passenger journey increased to 121 from 120 miles the average revenue earned per passenger-mile dropped to 2.983 cents from 3.079.

The December 1958 ratio of railway operating expenses to operating revenues declined to 90.75 per cent from 94.40.
