RAILWAY OPERATING STATISTICS

OCTOBER 1959

Financial details of railways operating in Canada are submitted and published on a more current basis than operating statistics. Consequently, this report includes October financial and September operating data.

Financial Statistics

Railway operating revenues of the twenty-two reporting class 1 and 2 carriers rose 2.8 per cent during October to \$105,668,834 from \$102,801,723 in 1958. Operating expenses were also higher during the month under review, rising 3.6 per cent to \$98,214,802 from \$94,765,114. As a result the net operating income dropped to \$7,454,032 from \$8,036,609.

The Canadian National Railways reported operating revenues of \$50,418,265, down slightly from \$51,004,799 a year earlier. Operating expenses, on the other hand, were up 5.6 per cent to \$49,413,522 from \$46,810,079 thus producing a net railway operating income of \$1,004,743 as compared with \$4,194,720 in October 1958. Operating revenues of the Canadian Pacific Railway rose slightly to \$39,123,184 from \$38,985,895, while operating expenses were cut by 3.9 per cent to \$35,988,214 from \$37,440,065. Thus the net railway operating income rose to \$3,134,970, more than double the \$1,545,830 recorded the previous year.

Rail operating revenues, comprising railway, express, commercial communications and highway transport (rail) services, totalled \$115,322,991 in October 1959, up 3.0 per cent from \$112,012,098 in 1958. Rail operating expenses rose 3.7 per cent to \$107,245,580 from \$103,381,554 and the net rail operating income amounted to \$8,077,411 in contrast to \$8,630,544.

Operating Statistics

Class 1 and 2 railways operating in Canada carried a total of 17,809,400 tons of revenue freight during September, as against 15,809,755 tons in the previous year. Revenue freight ton-miles also advanced rising to 6,106,626,-000 from 5,394,704,000 ton-miles. The average miles hauled rose slightly to 343. in 1959 from 341, while the average revenue received per ton-mile declined to 1.509 cents from 1.538. The number of revenue passengers carried numbered 1,743,814 during the month under review as compared with 1,746,152 in 1958. Passenger-miles rose, however, to 206,771,000 from 196,287,000 and as a result the average passenger journey measured 119 miles as against 112. The average revenue per passenger-mile was 3.261 cents versus 3.347 a year earlier.

The September ratio of operating expenses to revenues fell to 92.87 per cent from 95.22.
