RAILWAY OPERATING STATISTICS

NOVEMBER 1959

Financial details of railways operating in Canada are submitted and published on a more current basis than operating statistics. Consequently, this report includes November financial and October operating data.

Financial Statistics

Railway operating revenues of the twenty-two class 1 and 2 railways rose 6.1 per cent during the month of November, 1959, to \$99,501,493 from \$93,755,280 in the previous year. Operating expenses declined, however, to \$94,191,371 from \$97,406,626, or by 3.3 per cent leaving a net operating income of \$5,310,122 as opposed to a loss of \$3,651,346 in 1958.

Operating revenues of the Canadian National Railways increased 5.8 per cent to \$46,830,448 from \$44,270,775 in 1958. Operating expenses dropped 11.0 per cent to \$47,860,148 from \$53,778,690 resulting in a net operating loss of \$1,029,700 as compared with one of \$9,507,915 a year earlier. The Canadian Pacific Railway Company reported a drop of 2.9 per cent in operating revenues to \$39,092,749 from \$40,245,952. Operating expenses fell to a lesser degree, dropping 0.4 per cent to \$34,859,061 from \$34,992,794. As a result, the net operating income amounted to \$4,233,688 down from \$5,253,158 in 1958.

Rail operating revenues, comprising railway, express, commercial communications and highway transport (rail) services totalled \$109,134,841, up 6.0 per cent from \$102,973,291 in 1958. Rail operating expenses declined 2.9 per cent to \$103,217,171 from \$106,283,245 and the net operating income rose to \$5,917,670 from a deficit of \$3,309,954.

Operating Statistics

Revenue freight carried by railways in Canada during the month of October rose to 18,197,128 tons from 16,812,815 and the number of ton-miles increased to 6,376,294,000 from 6,058,344,000. The average miles hauled, declined to 350 from 360 and the average revenue per ton-mile dropped slightly to 1.452 cents from 1.487. Fewer passengers were carried during the month, dropping to 1,593,355 from 1,668,012, while passenger miles increased to 167,875,000 from 165,932,000 for an average journey of 105 miles as compared with 99 in the previous year. The average revenue received per passenger mile fell slightly to 3.040 cents from 3.087.

The October 1959 ratio of railway operating expenses to operating revenues rose to 92.95 per cent from 92.18.
