RAILWAY OPERATING STATISTICS

OCTOBER 1960

Financial details of railways operating in Canada are submitted and published on a more current basis than operating statistics. Consequently, this report includes the October financial and September operating results of class 1 and 2 roads, (the C.N.R., C.P.R. and other carriers having average gross revenues of \$500,000 or more annually).

Financial Statistics

Railway operating revenues during the month of October totalled \$95,406,-595, a decline of 9.7 per cent from \$105,668,834 in 1959. Operating expenses were down 4.0 per cent to \$94,322,945 from \$98,214,802, and as a result, the net operating income was \$1,083,650 as compared with \$7,454,032 in October 1959.

The Canadian National Railways reported a 14.9 per cent decrease in railway operating revenues to \$42,884,666 from \$50,418,265. Operating expenses were down 6.0 per cent to \$46,452,419 from \$49,413,522 leaving a net operating loss of \$3,567,753 as compared with an income of \$1,004,743 in 1959. The Canadian Pacific Railway Company registered a slight decline in railway operating revenues to \$39,-048,309 from \$39,123,184. Operating expenses declined to \$35,964,597 from \$35,988,-214 and, as a result, the net operating income fell to \$3,083,712 from \$3,134,970 in the previous year.

Rail operating revenues, comprising railway, express, commercial communication and highway transport (rail) services, totalled \$105,116,134, down 8.9 per cent from \$115,322,991 in 1959. Rail operating expenses fell 3.9 per cent to \$103,-110,197 from \$107,245,580 and the net rail operating income dropped to \$2,005,937 from \$8,077,411 in October 1959.

Operating Statistics

Tons of revenue freight carried during the month of September amounted to 17,276,587 tons, down 3.0 per cent from 17,809,380 in the previous year. The number of ton-miles increased to 6,192,791,000 from 6,106,626,000 and the average haul rose to 358 miles from 343. The average revenue per ton-mile of freight declined slightly to 1.346 cents from 1.509. Fewer passengers were carried during the month, dropping to 1,611,532 from 1,743,814 and passenger miles fell to 183,601,000 from 206,771,000. The average journey decreased to 114 miles from 119 and the average revenue earned per passenger mile dropped to 3.227 from 3.261 cents.

The September 1960 ratio of railway operating expenses to revenues rose to 98.37 per cent from 92.87.
