

RAILWAY OPERATING STATISTICS

As financial statistics of railways operating in Canada are submitted and published on a more current basis than operating data, it has become the practice to publish the financial section one month ahead of the operating. Consequently, this report includes the August financial and July operating results of class 1 and 2 roads.

Financial Statistics

Railway operating revenues during the month of August declined 4.9 per cent to \$100,230,152 from \$105,367,755 in 1959 while operating expenses dropped 1.7 per cent to \$98,254,432 from \$99,964,206. As a result, the net railway operating income fell to \$1,975,720 from \$5,403,549.

The Canadian National Railways recorded a 5.5 per cent drop in operating revenues to \$46,510,882 from \$49,221,580. Operating expenses were down 1.5 per cent to \$48,596,722 from \$49,344,804 resulting in a net operating loss of \$2,085,840 as compared with one of \$123,224 in August 1959. The Canadian Pacific Railway Company also registered a drop in operating revenues, down 4.6 per cent to \$38,443,229 from \$40,314,405. Operating expenses declined 4.3 per cent to \$36,314,366 from \$37,950,246 and, as a result, the net operating income fell to \$2,128,863 from \$2,364,159 in the previous year.

Rail operating revenues, comprising railway, express, commercial communications and highway transport (rail) services, totalled \$109,945,453, down 4.3 per cent from \$114,933,515 in 1959. Rail operating expenses dropped 1.6 per cent to \$107,084,687 from \$108,862,594 and the net rail operating income fell to \$2,860,766 from \$6,070,921 in August 1959.

Operating Statistics

Revenue freight carried during the month of July, 1960 totalled 16,263,-748 tons, down 8.0 per cent from 17,686,768 in the previous year. The number of ton-miles dropped to 5,838,710,000 from 6,354,026,000 while the average haul held at 359 miles. The average revenue per ton-mile of freight dropped slightly to 1.412 cents from 1.424. Fewer passengers were carried during the month, dropping 12.5 per cent to 1,609,713 from 1,838,714. Passenger miles fell to 273,232,000 from 316,590,000 and the average passenger journey declined to 170 miles from 172. The average revenue earned per passenger mile rose to 2.997 cents from 2.849.

The July 1960 ratio of railway operating expenses to revenues rose to 96.43 per cent from 93.10.
