RAILWAY OPERATING STATISTICS

SEPTEMBER 1960

Financial details of railways operating in Canada are submitted and published on a more current basis than operating statistics. Consequently, this report includes the September financial and August operating results of class 1 and 2 roads, (the C.N.R., C.P.R. and other carriers having average gross revenues of \$500,000 or more annually).

Financial Statistics

Railway operating revenues during the month of September totalled \$96,795,-613 a decline of 9.1 per cent from \$106,513,001 in 1959. Operating expenses were down 3.7 per cent to \$95,220,445 from \$98,917,972, and as a result the net operating income was \$1,575,168 as compared with \$7,595,029 in September 1959.

The Canadian National Railways reported a 17.2 per cent decrease in railway operating revenues to \$43,092,412 from \$52,058,138. Operating expenses were down 6.0 per cent to \$46,839,976 from \$49,832,953 leaving a net operating loss of \$3,747,564 as compared with an income of \$2,225,185 in 1959. The Canadian Pacific Railway Company reported an increase in railway operating revenues of 0.6 per cent to \$37,-964,704 from \$37,756,058. Operating expenses, however, dropped 0.7 per cent to \$35,346,675 from \$35,601,618 and, as a result the net operating income rose to \$2,618,029 from \$2,154,440 in the previous year.

Rail operating revenues, comprising railway, express, commercial communications and highway transport (rail) services, totalled \$106,661,420 down 8.3 per cent from \$116,274,363 in 1959. Rail operating expenses fell 3.6 per cent to \$104,168,796 from \$108,090,353 and the net rail operating income dropped to \$2,492,-624 from \$8,184,010 in September 1959.

Operating Statistics

Tons of revenue freight carried during the month of August amounted to 16,540,300 tons, down 2.0 per cent from 16,880,023 in the previous year. The number of ton-miles dropped to 5,795,017,000 from 6,182,287,000 and the average haul fell to 350 miles from 366. The average revenue per ton-mile of freight rose slightly to 1.464 cents from 1.436. Fewer passengers were carried during the month dropping to 1,696,330 from 1,867,070 and passenger miles fell to 249,544,000 from 273,503,000. The average journey rose slightly to 147 miles from 146, while the average revenue earned per passenger mile dropped to 3.003 cents from 3.117.

The August 1960 ratio of railway operating expenses to revenues rose to 98.03 per cent from 94.87.
