RAILWAY OPERATING STATISTICS

January 1961

Financial details of railways operating in Canada are submitted and published on a more current basis than operating statistics. Consequently, this report includes the January financial and December operating results of class 1 and 2 roads, (the C.N.R., C.P.R. and other carriers having average gross revenues of \$500,000 or more annually).

Financial Statistics

Railway operating revenues during the month of January declined 4.6 per cent to \$82,545,428 from \$86,514,318 in 1960. Operating expenses dropped to a greater degree, declining 5.8 per cent to \$87,001,651 from \$92,352,776 resulting in a net operating loss of \$4,456,223 as compared with one of \$5,838,458 a year earlier.

The Canadian National Railways reported a decrease in operating revenues of 2.6 per cent to \$39,880,314 from \$40,929,545 in 1960. Operating expenses fell 6.0 per cent to \$44,927,949 from \$47,775,535 leaving a net operating deficit of \$5,047,635 in contrast to one of \$6,845,990 in 1960. The Canadian Pacific Railway Company reported a decline in operating revenues of 4.8 per cent to \$33,893,519 from \$35,608,418. Operating expenses declined 4.3 per cent to \$33,620,416 from \$35,118,-295 resulting in a drop in net operating income to \$273,103 from \$490,123 in 1960.

Rail operating revenues, comprising railway, express, commercial communications and highway transport (rail) services declined 2.9 per cent to \$92,037,290 from \$94,750,497 in 1960. Rail operating expenses decreased 4.4 per cent to \$95,-595,142 from \$100,018,006, leaving a net operating loss of \$3,557,852 as compared with one of \$3,340,970.

Operating Statistics

Revenue freight carried during the month of December 1960 declined 9.3 per cent to 12,641,149 tons from 13,944,325 and the number of ton-miles dropped to 4,938,901,000 from 5,206,298,000. The average length of haul rose, however, to 391 miles from 373 while the average revenue per ton-mile dropped to 1.471 cents from 1.642 cents. Revenue passengers carried during the month were down to 1,719,602 from 1,933,666 and passenger miles dropped to 208,031,000 from 221,552,000. The average passenger journey rose to 121 miles from 115, and the average revenue earned per passenger mile increased to 3.030 cents from 2.973 cents.

The December 1960 ratio of railway operating expenses to operating revenues declined to 82.40 per cent from 97.08.
