February 1961.

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Financial details of railways operating in Canada are submitted and published on a more current basis than operating statistics. Consequently, this report includes the February financial and January operating results of class 1 and 2 roads, (the C.N.R., C.P.R. and other carriers having average gross revenues of \$500,000 or more annually).

#### Financial Statistics

Railway operating revenues during the month of February declined 13.5 per cent to \$81,997,426 from \$94,776,997 in 1960. Operating expenses were also lower, dropping 8.9 per cent to \$85,373,976 from \$93,749,601, resulting in a net operating loss of \$3,376,550 as compared with an income of \$1,027,396 a year earlier.

The Canadian National Railways reported a decrease in operating revenues of 14.2 per cent to \$40,600,996 from \$47,346,877 in 1960. Operating expenses fell 8.5 per cent to \$44,114,285 from \$48,233,209 leaving a net operating loss of \$3,513,289 as compared to a loss of \$886,332 in 1960. The Canadian Pacific Railway Company reported a decline in operating revenues of 10.7 per cent to \$33,302,107 from \$37,286,631. Operating expenses fell 8.4 per cent to \$32,720,982 from \$35,-740,464 and operating income declined to \$581,125 from \$1,546,167 in 1960.

Rail operating revenues, comprising railway, express, commercial communications and highway transport (rail) services declined 12.3 per cent to \$91,094,458 from \$103,869,338 in 1960. Rail operating expenses decreased 8.3 per cent to \$93,729,241 from \$102,163,139 leaving a net rail operating deficit of \$2,634,783 as compared with a net income of \$1,706,199 in 1960.

#### Operating Statistics

Revenue freight carried during the month of January declined 3.4 per cent to 11,804,669 tons from 12,221,820 and the number of ton-miles dropped to 4,652,239,-000 from 4,887,333,000. The average length of haul fell to 394 miles from 400 while the average revenue per ton-mile increased to 1.540 cents from 1.518. Revenue passengers carried during the month were down to 1,666,327 from 1,699,367 and passenger miles dropped to 142,022,000 from 167,188,000. The average passenger journey fell to 85 miles from 98, while the average revenue per passenger mile rose slightly to 3.102 cents from 3.030 cents.

The January 1961 ratio of railway operating expenses to operating revenues declined to 105.54 per cent from 106.75.
