#### RAILWAY OPERATING STATISTICS

OCTOBER 1963

Presented in this report are the October 1963 Financial statistics and the September 1963 operating results of class 1 and 2 carriers (the C.N.R., C.P.R. and other railways having average gross revenues of \$500,000 or more annually). Excluded are details of class 3 and 4 roads (those with operating revenues of less than \$500,000) whose operations represent about one per cent of all common carrier railways.

While operating statistics of the Cartier Railway Company have been included in some of the other rail transport series since August 1962, they are omitted from this report due to non-availability of the necessary data.

#### Financial Statistics

Railway operating revenues in October 1963 increased 8.7 per cent to \$109,390,165 over the previous October. Operating expenses rose to a lesser degree, increasing 3.9 per cent to \$99,041,583. This resulted in a net operating income of \$10,348,582 as compared to \$5,320,898 in the same month a year earlier. October 1963 railway operating expenses amounted to 90.54 cents per dollar of revenue.

The Canadian National Railways reported a 17.0 per cent increase in operating revenues to \$53,821,349 while the Canadian Pacific Railway Company showed a 4.2 per cent increase to \$42,139,359. In comparing the revenues of the two roads it should be noted that C.N.R. included in freight receipts their October 1963 share of all subsidies, including approximately \$0.8 million relating to the Freight Rates Reduction Act and \$2.0 million in interim payments relating to the recommendations of the Royal Commission on Transportation. Previous year C.N.R. figures excluded the latter two payments. C.P.R. revenues for the month under review included Freight Rates Reduction Act payments of \$0.6 million but excluded those relative to the Royal Commission. October 1962 C.P.R. data has been restated and are all inclusive. Operating expenses of the Canadian National increased 4.8 per cent to \$49,228,061, while the Canadian Pacific reported expenses of \$38,833,283, 4.6 per cent higher than the previous year. The C.N.R.'s net operating income for the month of October 1963 amounted to \$4,593,288 in comparison with a deficit of \$980,332 a year earlier. The C.P.R., on the other hand, showed a net operating income of \$3,306,076, down from \$3,311,961 in October 1962.

Rail operating revenues, comprising railway, express commercial communications and highway transport (rail) services rose 8.2 per cent to \$120,674,672. Operating expenses were higher by 3.9 per cent, rising to \$109,391,338 and the net operating income was up to \$11,283,334 from \$6,173,715 in the preceding year.

## Operating Statistics

During September 1963, the railways carried 16.6 million tons of revenue freight, up 5.5 per cent for the same period in 1962. For a more complete analysis and breakdown of tonnage statistics see the monthly series entitled, "Freight Traffic" Catalogue Number 52-002. The number of ton-miles in September rose 7.4 per cent to 6,232,736,000. The average length of haul increased to 376 from 370 miles. The average revenue per ton-mile of freight, however, declined slightly to 1.420 cents from 1.423. The number of passengers carried during the month of September rose 10.1 per cent to 1,742 thousand while passenger-miles dropped 8.2 per cent to 156 million. The average passenger journey dropped to 90 miles from 108 and the average revenue earned per passenger-mile declined to 2.918 cents from 2.960.
