RAILWAY OPERATING STATISTICS

NOVEMBER 1963

Presented in this report are the November 1963 financial statistics and the October 1963 operating results of class 1 and 2 carriers operating in Canada (the C.N.R., C.P.R. and other railways having average gross revenues of \$500,000 or more annually). Excluded are details of class 3 and 4 roads (those with operating revenues of less than \$500,000) whose operations represent about one per cent of all common carrier railways.

While operating statistics of the Cartier Railway have been included in some of the other rail transport series since August 1962, they are omitted from this report due to the non-availability of related financial data.

Financial Statistics

Total railway operating revenues in November 1963 decreased 12.4 per cent to \$102,614,199 from the previous year. Operating expenses increased 6.6 per cent to \$97,347,320 resulting in a net operating income of \$5,266,879 as compared to \$25,838,300 in the same month a year earlier. November 1963 railway operating expenses amounted to 94.87 cents per dollar of revenue.

The Canadian National Railways reported a 27.1 per cent decline in operating revenues to \$50,864,884, while the Canadian Pacific Railway Company showed a 9.2 per cent increase to \$41,225,061. The substantial decline in operating revenues of the Canadian National are accountable by the fact that their previous year figures included accumulated January to November 1962 payments of approximately \$26.6 millions related to the recommendations of the Royal Commission on Transportation. Compensatory payments made under the Freight Rates Reduction Act were excluded. November 1963 C.N.R. revenues embraced only that month's portion of subventions, including \$0.9 million F.R.R.A. and \$2.0 million Royal Commission payments. Operating revenues of the Canadian Pacific Railway for November 1963 included approximately \$0.6 million in F.R.R.A. payments but excluded those relative to the Royal Commission. In the previous November only Royal Commission payments for that month was included by the C.P.R. Operating expenses of the Canadian National increased 2.2 per cent to \$48,677,274, while the Canadian Pacific reported expenses of \$38,436,303, 11.5 per cent higher than the previous year. The C.N.R. net operating income for the month of November 1963 amounted to \$2,187,610 in comparison with \$22,139,583 one year earlier. The C.P.R. showed a net operating income of \$2,788,758, down from \$3,297,387 in November 1962.

Rail operating revenues, comprising railway, express, commercial communications and highway transport (rail) services dropped 11.1 per cent to \$113,546,807. Operating expenses were higher by 6.1 per cent, rising to \$107,496,757 resulting in a drop in net operating income to \$6,050,050 from \$26,-401,423 in the preceding year.

Operating Statistics

During October 1963, the railways carried 18.7 million tons of revenue freight, up 11.9 per cent from the same period in 1962. For a more complete analysis and provincial breakdown of tonnage statistics see the monthly series entitled, "Freight Traffic" Catalogue Number 52-002. The number of ton-miles in October rose 16.6 per cent to 7,200 million. The average length of haul increased to 385 from 370 miles. The average revenue per ton-mile of freight, however, declined to 1.363 cents from 1.466. The number of passengers carried during the month of October rose 6.6 per cent to 1,742 thousand and passenger-miles rose 9.7 per cent to 140 million. The average passenger journey rose to 81 miles from 78 and the average revenue earned per passenger-mile rose to 2.694 cents from 2.198.
