RAILWAY OPERATING STATISTICS

Financial details of railways operating in Canada are available for publication earlier than operating statistics. Consequently, this report presents the financial data relating to August 1963 and the operating results for July of class 1 and 2 roads, (the C.N.R., C.P.R. and other carriers having average gross revenues of \$500,000 or more annually). Excluded are details of class 3 and 4 roads (those with operating revenues of less than \$500,000) whose operations represent about one per cent of all common carrier railways.

While statistics of the Cartier Railway Company have been included in other rail transport series since August 1962, they are omitted from this report due to the necessary data not being available.

Financial Statistics

Railway operating revenues in August 1963 declined 1.1 per cent to \$98,434,682 from August one year earlier. Operating expenses dropped to a greater degree, decreasing 3.2 per cent to \$94,474,999. This resulted in a net operating income of \$3,959,683 as compared to one of \$1,953,291 in the same month one year earlier. August 1963 railway operating expenses amounted to 95.98 cents per dollar of

The Canadian National Railways reported a 2.7 per cent increase in operating revenues to \$48,-489,410 while the Canadian Pacific Railway Company showed a 4.3 per cent decline to \$36,171,671. In comparing the above revenues of the two roads it should be noted that C.N.R. freight receipts for August 1963 included approximately \$2 million in interim payments relating to recommendations of the Royal Commission on Transportation, while C.P.R. earnings excluded their share of this subsidy. Freight Rates Reduction Act payments were reported in both C.N.R. and C.P.R. freight revenues and amounted to approximately \$0.8 million and \$0.6 million, respectively. Operating expenses of the Canadian National were down 2.7 per cent to \$48,012,490 and the Canadian Pacific reported a decline of 2.2 per cent to \$35,315,561. The C.N.R.'s net operating income for the month of August amounted to \$476,920 in comparison with a deficit of \$2,125,792 a year earlier. The C.P.R., on the other hand, showed a net operating income of \$856,110, down from \$1,686,496 in August 1962.

Rail operating revenues, comprising railway, express, commercial communications and highway transport (rail) services declined 1.1 per cent to \$109,380,153. Operating expenses dropped 2.9 per cent to \$104,751,338 and the net rail operating income rose to \$4,628,815 from \$2,735,592 in August 1962.

Operating Statistics

During July 1963, the railways carried over 16 million tons of revenue freight, virtually unchanged from the previous year. The number of ton-miles rose 3.6 per cent to over 6,000 million and, as a result, the average length of haul rose to 374 miles from 360. The average revenue per ton-mile of freight declined to 1.408 cents from 1.422. The number of passengers carried during the month of July rose 2.4 per cent to 1,828 thousand, while passenger-miles dropped 7.9 per cent to 257 million. The resulting average journey dropped to 140 miles from 156 and the average revenue earned per passenger-mile fell to 2.786 cents from 2.815.
