RAILWAY OPERATING STATISTICS

JANUARY 1965

Presented in this report are the January 1965 financial results and the December 1964 traffic statistics of class 1 and 2 railways (the C.N.R., C.P.R. and other lines having average gross revenues of \$500,000 or more annually). Excluded are details of class 3 and 4 roads (those with revenues of less than \$500,000) whose operations represent about one per cent of all common carrier railways.

Included in this series for the first time are statistics of the Arnaud Railway Company and the Wabush Lake Railway Company operating in the provinces of Quebec and Newfoundland. Traffic results of the Cartier Railway Company, which also operates in Quebec, are included in certain other rail transport reports, but are omitted from this particular series because relative financial data is not available.

Financial Statistics

Canadian common carrier railway operating revenues in January 1965 decreased 3.5 per cent to \$101,536,014 from the preceding year, while operating expenses rose 0.2 per cent to \$101,400,558. This resulted in a total net operating income of \$135,456 as compared to \$4,021,637 in January 1964. January 1965 railway operating expenses amounted to 99.87 cents per dollar of revenue.

Canadian lines of the Canadian National Railways experienced a 1.9 per cent drop in operating revenues to \$50,592,007 and a 1.5 per cent rise in operating expenses to \$51,715,992. This resulted in a net operating deficit of \$1,123,985 as compared with a net operating income of \$644,930 a year earlier. The Canadian Pacific Railway Company reported a 6.0 per cent decline in January 1965 revenues to \$40,160,253, and a 3.3 per cent drop in operating expenses to \$38,976,675. The C.P.R. net operating income totalled \$1,183,578, down from \$2,406,893 in January 1964.

Rail operating revenues, which comprise railway, express, commercial communications and highway transport (rail) service revenues, dropped 2.7 per cent to \$112,293,256. Operating expenses were higher by 0.7 per cent, rising to \$111,483,987 and, as a result, the net rail operating income dropped to \$809,269 from \$4,722,341 in the preceding year.

Traffic Statistics

During December 1964, the railways carried 16.9 million tons of revenue freight, an increase of 9.8 per cent over the same period in 1963. For a more complete analysis and provincial breakdown of commodity statistics see the monthly series entitled "Freight Traffic", catalogue number 52-002. The number of revenue ton-miles dropped 4.5 per cent to 6,356 million in December while the average length of haul dropped to 375 miles from 431. The average revenue per ton-mile of freight rose to 1.471 cents from 1.347. The number of passengers carried during the month of December rose 4.9 per cent to 2,082 thousand and passenger-miles increased 3.6 per cent to 241 million. The average passenger journey dropped slightly to 116 miles from 117 while the average revenue earned per passenger-mile dropped to 2,631 cents from 2.701.
