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RAILWAY OPERATING STATISTICS

NOVEMBER 1967

Detailed in this report are November 1967 and comparable 1966 financial data and traffic results of twenty-three class 1 and 2 railways operating in Canada (the C.N.R., C.P.R. and other lines having average gross revenues of \$500,000 or more annually). Excluded from both years are statistics of class 3 and 4 roads (those with revenues of less than \$500,000) whose operations represent about one per cent of all common carrier railways.

Financial Statistics

Operating revenues of twenty-three common carrier railways in November 1967 decreased 3.5 per cent to \$123,153,503 from the previous year. Operating expenses, in contrast to the earlier year, dropped 1.3 per cent to \$115,471,076 and the resultant net operating income was \$7,682,427, down from \$10,649,990 in the 1966 month. November 1967 railway expenses amounted to 93.76 cents per dollar of revenue.

Operating expenses of the Canadian National Railways rose less than 1.0 per cent to \$61,264,048 in November 1967 while revenues declined 2.3 per cent to \$64,445,103. Consequently, net operating income at \$3,181,055 was down from \$5,119,464 in the previous year month. The Canadian Pacific Railway Company reported a 4.2 per cent decrease in operating revenues in November 1967, to \$46,012,955 and a 4.0 per cent drop in operating expenses to \$42,382,556. C.P.R. net income at \$3,630,399 was down from \$3,902,951 in November 1966.

Rail operating revenues, which comprise those of railway, express, commercial communications and highway transport (rail) services, declined 3.0 per cent to \$136,491,420. Operating expenses at \$127,583,908 were down by 1.3 per cent and a net rail operating income of \$8,907,512 was recorded in contrast to \$11,467,008 during the same month of the preceding year.

Traffic Statistics

A total of 20.3 million tons of revenue freight was hauled by railways in Canada during November, down 4.7 per cent from the same 1966 period. The number of ton miles generated dropped to 7,305 million from 8,022 million and the average haul at 360 miles was down 17 from the previous year. The average revenue earned per ton-mile of freight rose to 1.498 cents from 1.426. The number of revenue passengers carried during November declined 12.6 per cent to 1,749 thousand and passenger miles fell 12.3 per cent to 166 million. The resulting average passenger journey at 95 miles paralleled that of the 1966 figure. Employment in the industry at 121,366 continued to drop, declining from 130,587 in November 1966 and from 128,680 in October 1967.
