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RAILWAY OPERATING STATISTICS

DECEMBER 1967

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Detailed in this report are December 1967 and 1966 financial data and traffic results of twenty-three class 1 and 2 common carrier railways operating in Canada (the C.N.R., C.P.K. and other lines having average gross revenues of \$500,000 or more annually). Excluded from both years are statistics of class 3 and 4 roads (those with revenues of less than \$500,000) whose operations represent about one per cent of all railways.

Financial Statistics

Operating revenues of twenty-three common carrier railways in December 1967 decreased 14.8 per cent to \$120,384,750 from the previous year. This notable disparity was attributable in part to the inclusion in December 1966 C.N.R. freight revenues of \$17.5 million received from the Federal Government in respect to retroactive wage awards. Operating expenses decreased 8.6 per cent to \$108,009,237 from the previous year month resulting in a net operating income of \$12,375,513 in the period under review, compared to \$23,114,125 a year earlier. December 1967 railway expenses amounted to 89.72 cents per dollar of revenue.

The Canadian National Railways recorded a 22.8 per cent decline in operating revenues to \$62,404,271 (mainly because of the above-noted 1966 wage awards), while operating expenses at \$51,303,859 were down 19.0 per cent from the previous year. Net operating income at \$11,100,412 was down from \$16,151,744 recorded in the earlier year. Operating revenues of the Canadian Pacific Railway Company decreased 6.0 per cent during the month of December to \$45,506,380 and operating expenses were down 1.7 per cent to \$41,197,381. The C.P.R. net railway operating income totalled \$4,308,999, down from \$6,480,989.

Rail operating revenues, which comprise those of railway, express, commercial communications and highway transport (rail) services fell 13.4 per cent for all roads to \$134,294,457. Rail operating expenses were down by 8.3 per cent, dropping to \$120,144,802 and, as a result, the net rail income decreased to \$14,149,655 as compared with \$24,123,900 in the preceding year.

Traffic Statistics

A total of 18.4 million tons of revenue freight was handled by railways in Canada during December, down 3.3 per cent from the same period of 1966. The number of ton-miles generated dropped to 7,199 million from 7,780 million and the average haul at 392 miles decreased 18 miles from the earlier year. The average revenue earned per ton-mile of freight dropped to 1.474 cents from 1.623. The number of revenue passengers carried during December declined 13.9 per cent to 1,724 thousand. Passenger-miles dropped 4.6 per cent to 212 million but the average passenger journey increased to 123 miles from 111. The average revenue earned per passenger-mile decreased to 2.569 cents from 2.720 cents in the earlier year.
