RAILWAY OPERATING STATISTICS

APRIL 1967

Presented in this report are the April 1967 and 1966 financial and traffic results of twenty-three class 1 and 2 railways (the C.N.R., C.P.R. and other lines having average gross revenues of \$500,000 or more annually). Excluded from both years are statistics of class 3 and 4 roads (those with revenues of less than \$500,000) whose operations represent about one per cent of all common carrier railways.

Financial Statistics

Operating revenues of twenty-three common carrier railways in April 1967 declined 1.4 per cent to \$120,982,024 from the previous year. In contrast, operating expenses at \$119,085,410 were higher by 4.0 per cent resulting in a decline in net operating income to \$1,896,614 from \$8,104,700 one year earlier. April 1967 railway expenses amounted to 98.43 cents per dollar of revenue.

The Canadian National Railways recorded a 0.4 per cent decrease in operating revenues to \$61,-737,472 and a 6.8 per cent increase in operating expenses to \$64,396,814. This resulted in a net operating loss of \$2,659,342 as compared with a profit of \$1,708,589 in 1966. The Canadian Pacific Railway Company reported a 2.0 per cent decrease in April 1967 revenues to \$46,829,708 and a 1.8 per cent rise in operating expenses to \$43,406,647. The C.P.R. net operating income totalled \$3,423,061, down from \$5,151,799 in 1966.

Rail operating revenues, which comprise railway, express, commercial communications and highway transport (rail) service revenues, declined 1.2 per cent to \$133,751,311. Rail operating expenses at \$131,009,676 were higher by 3.6 per cent, and a net operating profit of \$2,741,635 was recorded in contrast to \$8,903,583 during the same month of the preceding year.

Traffic Statistics

During April 1967, a total of 18.1 million tons of revenue freight was handled by railways in Canada, down 5.0 per cent from the same period a year earlier. The number of ton-miles generated in April declined to 7,339 million from 7,608 million and the average haul at 406 miles was up 7 from the earlier year. The average revenue earned per ton mile of freight increased to 1.466 cents from 1.435. The number of revenue passengers carried during April decreased 8.3 per cent to 1,741,442, while passenger miles fell 8.1 per cent to 211 million. The average passenger journey remained constant at 121 miles, while the average revenue earned per passenger-mile rose to 2.425 cents from 2.269 in the earlier year.
