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## RAILWAY OPERATING STATISTICS

**APRIL 1968** 

Presented in this report are April 1968 and 1967 financial and traffic results of twenty-four class 1 and 2 common carrier railways operating in Canada (the C.N.R., C.P.R. and other lines having average gross revenues of \$500,000 or more annually). Excluded from both years are statistics of class 3 and 4 roads (those with revenues of less than \$500,000) whose operations represent about one per cent of all railways.

Included in current year figures are results of the Ontario Government rail commuter services (GO), which began operating May 23, 1967 between Pickering and Hamilton, Ontario. While this service is operated by Canadian National, statistics pertaining therto are not included with those of that railway, hence the total number of reporting roads has been increased to 24 in 1968 from 23 in 1967.

## Financial Statistics

Operating revenues of reporting common carrier railways in April 1968, rose 2.5 per cent to \$124,284,621 from the previous year. In contrast, operating expenses at \$117,766,251 were lower by 1.2 per cent resulting in an increase in net operating income to \$6,518,370 from \$2,066,150 recorded one year earlier. April 1968 railway expenses amounted to 94.76 cents per dollar of revenue.

The Canadian National Railways recorded a 3.5 per cent increase in operating revenues to \$63,919,508 and a 4.6 per cent decline in operating expenses to \$61,449,128. This resulted in a net operating profit of \$2,470,380 in 1968 compared to a loss of \$2,659,342 in the previous year month. The Canadian Pacific reported a 0.7 per cent decline in operating revenues to \$46,680,588 and a 0.3 per cent decrease in operating expenses to \$43,381,061. The C.P. net operating income totalled \$3,299,527, down from \$3,502,727 in 1967.

Rail operating revenues, which comprise railway, express, commercial communications and highway transport (rail) service revenues, rose 3.2 per cent to \$138,371,265. Rail operating expenses at \$130,918,213 were slightly lower, and a net operating profit of \$7,453,052 was recorded compared to \$2,911,171 during the same month of the preceding year.

## Traffic Statistics

During April 1968, a total of 19.2 million tons of revenue freight was handled by railways in Canada, up 5.9 per cent from the same period a year earlier. The number of ton-miles generated in April rose to 7,403 million but the average haul at 386 was down 19 miles from the earlier year. The average revenue earned per ton-mile of freight increased to 1.510 cents from 1.470. The number of revenue passengers carried during April increased 16.8 per cent to 2,033,406 as commuter movements (due mainly to the inclusion of "GO" in 1968) registered an increase of 31.1 per cent. Non-commuter traffic fell 5.4 per cent. Passenger-miles fell 8.4 per cent to 193 million and the average passenger journey dropped to 95 miles from 121 miles. The average revenue earned per passenger-mile decreased to 2.365 cents from 2.425 in the earlier year.


