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traffic results of twenty-four class 1 and 2 common the gross revenues of \$550,000 or more annually).

Detailed in this report are September 1968 and 1967 financial and traffic results of twenty-four class 1 and 2 common carrier railways operating in Canada (the C.N.R., C.P. and other lines having gross revenues of \$500,000 or more annually). Excluded from both years are statistics of class 3 and 4 roads (those with revenues of less than \$500,000) whose operations represent about one per cent of all railways.

Included in both years are results of the Ontario Government rail commuter services (GO), which began operating May 23, 1967 between Pickering and Hamilton, Ontario (September 1967 data for this operation were based on a monthly average however because only June to December aggregates were available for the year). While the above-noted service is operated by Canadian National, statistics pertaining there to are not included with those of that railway. Thus, the number of reporting roads has been increased to 24 for both years shown.

Financial Statistics

Railway operating revenues of the twenty four common carrier railways decreased 4.6 per cent to \$123,417,631 from the previous year and were down 4.0 per cent from August 1968. Expenses at \$117,602,943 were lower by 2.8 per cent than the 1967 figure and a decline of 1.4 per cent from the August 1968 total of \$119,273,141. As a result, net operating income registered a profit or \$5,814,688 in contrast to \$8,400,008 in September 1967. September 1968 railway expenses amounted to 95.29 cents per dollar of revenue.

The Canadian National Railways recorded a 4.0 per cent decrease in operating revenues to \$63,690,747 and a 4.4 per cent decline in operating expenses to \$62,667,628. This resulted in a net operating profit of \$1,023,119 as compared to one of \$782,186 in the previous year. The Canadian Pacific reported a 7.4 per cent drop in operating revenues to \$44,364,525 and a 4.9 per cent decrease in operating expenses to \$41,706,848. The C.P. net operating income totalled \$2,657,677 as compared to \$4,074,526 in 1967.

Rail operating revenues, which comprise railway, express, commercial communications and highway transport (rail) services, dropped 3.3 per cent to \$138,334,278. Operating expenses were down 1.6 per cent to \$131,181,270 and, as a result, the net rail operating income declined to \$7,153,008 from \$9,701,827 in 1967.

Traffic Statistics

During September 1968, a total of 20.8 million tons of revenue freight was handled by railways in Canada, up 2.4 per cent from the same period a year earlier. The number of ton-miles generated in September increased to 7,715 million from 7,626 million, while the average haul at 370 miles was down 5 miles from the earlier year. The average revenue earned per ton-mile decreased to 1.415 cents from 1.460 in 1967. The number of revenue passenger carried during September decreased 21.4 per cent to 2,102 thousand and passenger miles decreased to 214 million miles from 310 million miles in September 1967. The resulting average passenger journey decreased to 102 miles from 116 miles in 1967. The sharp contrasts noted above in passenger travel were no doubt influenced by Canada's World's Fair and centennial celebrations during 1967. The average revenue earned per passenger mile increased to 2.574 cents from 2.365 cents in 1967.

Employment in the railway industry (including only over-the-rail operations) dropped to 124,518 from 132,781 persons in 1967.




