RAILWAY OPERATING STATISTICS

STATISTIQUE DE L'EXPLOITATION FERROVIAIRE

JULY - 1970 - JUILLET

Show herein are the July 1970 and 1969 financial, traffic and operating statistics of 24 class 1 and class 2 common carrier railways operating in Canada those with gross revenues of \$500,000 or more annually. Excluded are statistics of class 3 and 4 roads whose operating revenues represent less than one per cent of all reporting lines.

Financial Statistics

Railway operating revenues for these 24 roads during July 1970 came to \$142,787,532, up 11.1 per cent from July 1969. Operating expenses rose 9.3 per cent to \$136,447,381 leaving net operating income sharply higher at \$6,340,151 up 71.9 per cent. The iron ore strike in 1969 would be a major factor behind these increases. For the first 7 months of 1970 net railway operating income rose 41.7 per cent to \$57,864,520.

Traffic and Operating Statistics

Revenue freight carried during July 1970 came to 1,396,401 tons, up 32.7 per cent from 1,122,337 tons in July 1969. Ton miles for this traffic rose nearly as sharply increasing 24.7 per cent to 9,460,059,000. Revenue per ton mile of freight eased to 1.315 cents from 1.457 cents a year earlier.

Revenue passengers carried eased 1.6 per cent to 1,972,390 and passenger miles declined 5.4 per cent to 82,836,000 resulting in a lower average passenger journey which dropped from 149 miles to 143 miles.

Freight train miles rose 5.9 per cent to 5,313,844. The per cent of total car miles run out empty came to 41.4 per cent, up sharply from 40.0 per cent in July 1969. Here again the effect of the 1969 iron ore strike appears evident.

While the number of railway employees declined 3.3 per cent to 121,424, their payroll was 5.5 per cent higher at \$83,431,997

Le présent bulletin renferme les statistiques de juillet 1969 et 1970 sur les finances, le trafic et l'exploitation de 24 entreprises de transport ferroviaire de 1<sup>re</sup> et de 2<sup>e</sup> classe en activité au Canada (celles dont les recettes brutes atteignent ou dépassent \$500,000 par année). La statistique relative aux entreprises de 3<sup>e</sup> et de 4<sup>e</sup> classe, dont les recettes représentent moins de 1 p. 100 de l'ensemble des recettes déclarées, est exclue.

Statistique financière

En juillet 1970, les recettes de ces 24 entreprises se sont élevées à \$142,787,532, soit 11.1 p. 100 de plus qu'en juillet 1969. Les frais d'exploitation ont crû de 9.3 p. 100 pour atteindre \$136,447,381. Le revenu net d'exploitation, qui s'élève à \$6,340,151, s'est ainsi accru de 71.9 p. 100. La grève dans les mines de fer en 1969 a contribué pour une bonne part à l'écart entre les deux périodes. Au cours des sept premiers mois de 1970, le revenu net a augmenté de 41.7 p. 100 pour atteindre \$57,864,520.

Statistique du trafic

Le volume du fret transporté a augmenté de 32.7 p. 100, passant de 1,122,337 tonnes à 21,396,401 entre juillet 1969 et juillet 1970. Le nombre de tonnes-milles de fret a crû dans une mesure presque identique pour atteindre 9,460,059,000 (+24.7 p. 100). Les recettes moyennes par tonne-mille ont été de 1.315 cents contre 1.457 en juillet 1969.

Le nombre de voyageurs payants a diminué de 1.6 p. 100, à 1,972,390; le nombre de voyageurs-milles a aussi diminué (5.4 p. 100) pour tomber à 82,836,000. Le parcours moyen par voyageur est donc passé de 149 milles à 143.

Le nombre de trains-milles (service marchandises) a augmenté de 5.9 p. 100 pour atteindre 5,313,844. Le pourcentage de wagons-milles (wagons vides) a crû de façon nette, passant de 40.0 à 41.1 p. 100 entre les deux périodes. Ici encore, les effets de la grève de 1969 dans les mines de fer semblent évidents.

Si, d'une part, l'effectif des entreprises de transport ferroviaire a diminué de 0.3 p. 100, à 121,424, la rémunération des employés, d'autre part, s'est accrue de 5.5 p. 100 pour s'élever à \$83,431,997.

1969-1970



1969-1970


