The passenger traffic of electric railway systems continued to increase reaching a new peak in 1944 at 1,249,707,399 fare passengers carried by electric cars, trolley buses and motor buses of these systems. This does not include the urban traffic of systems using motor buses only, such as in Windsor, Sarnia, London, etc. Both the increase and the rate of increase over 1943 traffic were less than the annual increases during the preceding four years. The Kitchener Railway showed an increase of 25.25 per cent, the Oshawa System an increase of 22.12 per cent and the Port Arthur System an increase of 20.96 per cent. Other systems showed smaller increases and the Montreal System, with the largest traffic, showed an increase of only 1.89 per cent. Fifteen systems each transported ten million and more passengers during the year, and these systems accounted for 94 per cent of the traffic of all systems. The Montreal System carried 28.89 per cent of the total traffic and the Toronto System and its subsidiaries carried 24.35 per cent.

The operating revenues of all electric railway systems increased from \$80,027,414 in 1943 to \$84,730,173 or by 5.9 per cent. Operating expenses increased from \$54,548,335 to \$58,202,151 or by 6.7 per cent, increasing the net operating revenue from \$25,479,079 to \$26,528,022.

There was practically no change during the year in the track miles operated. The mileage run by electric cars increased from 124,454,463 in 1943 to 126,629,418, or by 1.8 per cent, trackless trolley buses showed an increase from 1,780,768 to 1,909,375 miles or 7.2 per cent, and motor buses an increase from 37,815,126 to 40,882,550 miles or 8.1 per cent. This was an approximate increase in total capacity of 2 to 3 per cent as compared with an increase in passengers carried of over 6 per cent. Each class of vehicle carried approximately the same percentage of the traffic as in 1943 but the number of passengers carried by each increased as follows:- electric car 6.5 per cent, trolley bus 15.5 per cent and motor bus 3.5 per cent. The number of electric cars in service at the end of the year increased from 3,458 in 1943 to 3,500, trolley buses increased from 41 to 42 and motor buses increased from 1,329 to 1,444, making the total increase from 4,828 to 4,986 vehicles. The number of car and bus motormen, conductors and operators increased from 9,599 to 10,224 and total employees increased from 17,896 to 19,034 or by 6.4 per cent for an increase in total pay roll from \$35,975,881 to \$36,845,132 or 2.5 per cent.

During the year 3 passengers were killed as compared with none in 1943, but the number injured was reduced from 4,301 to 3,980. The number of pedestrians killed increased from 52 to 60 and the number of injured increased from 1,002 to 1,072 in accidents involving vehicles of electric railway systems. Electric cars were involved in approximately 80 per cent of the accidents and motor buses in 19 per cent, trolley buses, work cars, etc., accounting for the remainder. Although there was an increase of 7.2 per cent in trolley bus mileage the number of trolley buses involved in accidents in which persons were injured decreased from 92 in 1943 to 20. The number of employees killed increased from 2 to 7 and the number injured from 722 to 835 or by 15.7 per cent.

The system in Montreal is operated under a contract between the City and the Company and the statistics are those of the operator, except that Table 6 shows also income data of the Company. This income includes certain allowances to the Company shown as expenses of operation, together with taxes, dividends, etc., payable by the Company.
