A summary of Express Statistics for the year ended December 31st, 1921 is given in the attached tables showing the principal details for each company operating in Canada.

The capital of the United States companies operating in Canada is not included in table 1. Effective September 1st the Canadian Express Company and the Canadian National Express Company were amalgamated and operated from that date as the Canadian National Express Company. A report was made for the first eight months by both companies and another report for the last four months by the amalgamated company, details of the three reports being given in this summary.

The following table giving comparative data from 1911, the first year Express Statistics were compiled, to 1921 inclusive, shows an increase over last year of \$1,992,390 in revenues and a decrease of \$519,693 in operating expenses while net operating revenues increased from a loss of \$1,982,337 to a net revenue of \$353,792.
