The express business over the lines of the Canadian National railways formerly handled by the Canadian National Express Company was handled by the Canadian National Railway as a department of the railway operation and the revenues, expenses, etc. for 1923 are included with the railway accounts. The gross operating revenues for the Canadian National Railway shown in the attached tables are the gross revenues of the express department and are included only for comparison purposes. The other totals for Canada consequently will not be comparable with those for previous years.

As in previous reports, the data for the American Railway Express Company pertains only to the Canadian investments and business.
