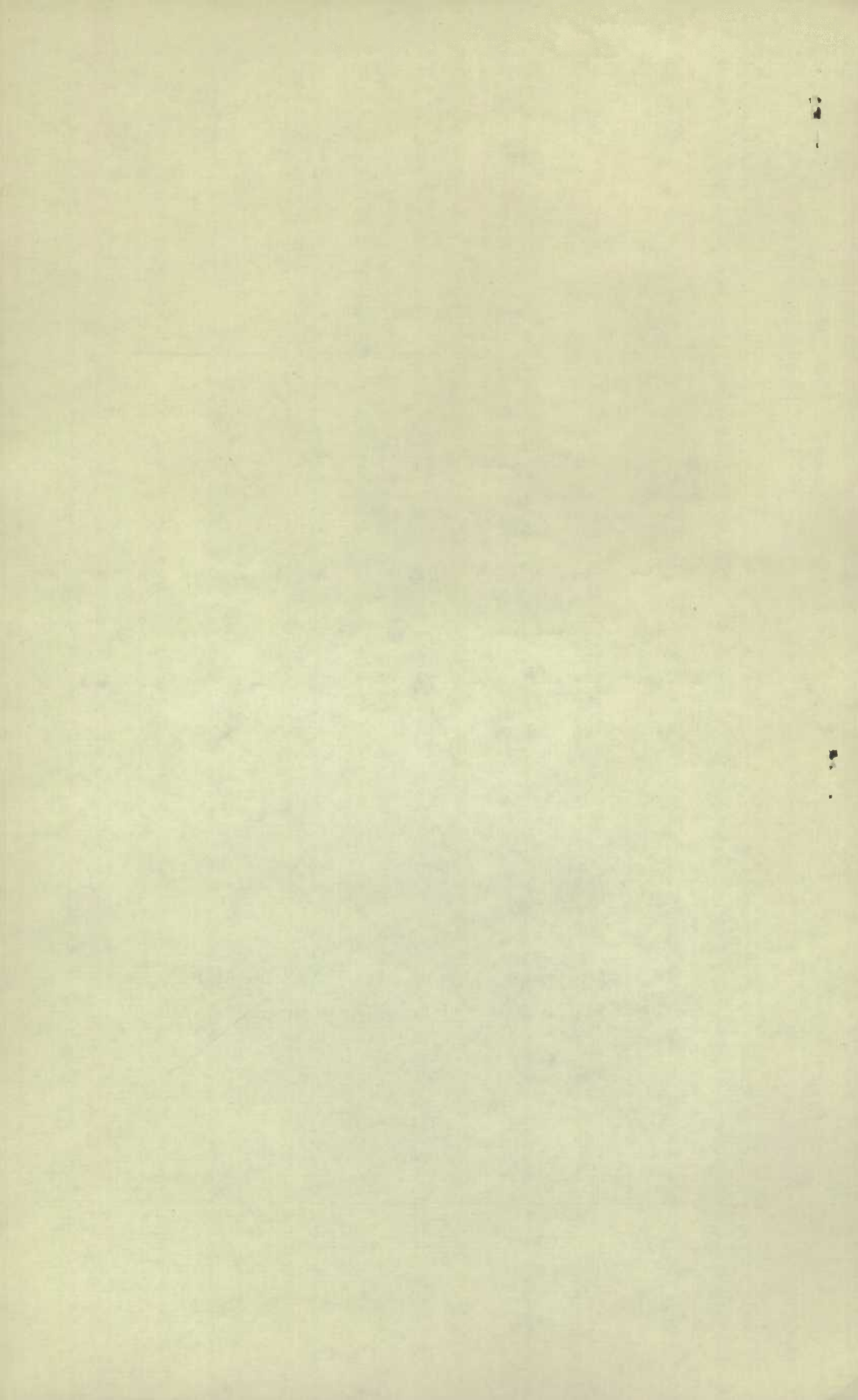

EXPRESS STATISTICS
FOR

1925

The following tables show the financial and operating statistics for 1925 of the express companies operating in Canada.

The express business over the Canadian Pacific Railway is handled by the Dominion Express Company, the stock being owned by the Canadian Pacific Railway. This express company also operated on 2,804 miles of other steam railways, on 113.5 miles of electric railways and on the Canadian Pacific ocean and lake steamboat lines. The express business of the Canadian National Railway is handled by a department of the railway and the tables include revenues and expenses of that department. The data in Table 1 are the stock of the express companies and the advances received from the railway system. The department handles the express business over the steam and electric lines and on the steam boats of the system and also on 1,213 miles of other steam railways and on several electric railways. The American Railway Express Company operated mainly on the Canadian sections of United States railways and the statistics cover only the Canadian operations. The British American Express Company operates over the lines of the Algoma Central and Hudson Bay and the Algoma Eastern railways and the Central Canada Express Company operates over the lines of the Edmonton, Dunvegan and British Columbia, the Central Canada, and the Alberta and Great Waterways railways.
