S U M M A R Y

O F

MONTHLY RAILWAY TRAFFIC REPORTS

FOR

YEAR ENDED DECEMBER 31, 1935.

The data in the following tables include only revenue freight carried by the Canadian railways and not the "on company service" freight which includes coal for locomotives, ties, ballast and other railway material. These data will consequently not check with data on imports although this freight will not affect the exports. Freight interchanged between Canadian roads is not duplicated in these tables, but freight unloaded and subsequently reshipped is counted each time it is billed out. Foreign connections include railways in the United States and boats cleared for, or entered from, foreign ports, and in this report all freight moved to ports on export rates has been shown as delivered to foreign connections. Although the railways report all grain delivered to the elevators at the head of the lakes as unloaded at stations in Canada and all grain received from the lake elevators as loaded at billing stations, the reports have been corrected from the elevator returns to show the deliveries to and receipts from foreign connections. Grain delivered to elevators at Montreal, Vancouver, and other ocean ports for export has been shown as delivered to foreign connections and adjustments have been made for grain taken out of these elevators for local consumption. Freight carried to ports on local rates has been reported as unloaded at stations although it might subsequently be exported by water routes. Grain unloaded at the elevators at the head of the lakes and later forwarded to Montreal by boat is reported as unloaded at stations in Ontario and does not again enter into the railway records, and consequently affects the net imports into the province. Also western grain grown in Ontario will increase the imports of grain since it is reported out as flour. Other provinces are similarly affected but to a less degree.

These data cover only railway revenue freight and the differences between column 1, freight loaded, and column 6, freight unloaded, are the net imports and exports by rail into and out of the respective provinces. If the loadings exceed the unloadings the data show a net export and if the unloadings exceed the loadings the excess is an import, irrespective of how often the same freight is loaded or unloaded. Except for freight handled by water, these data give a very complete picture of the movement of freight in Canada, and, in the Prairie Provinces where practically all freight is handled by rail, the net imports and exports cover all imports and exports into and out of these provinces.

A commodity may be imported and exported in another form such as wheat and flour, pulpwood and paper, etc., so that the net imports might be exported as other commodities.

Railways crossing the United States border consider their lines in the United States as foreign connections and show freight coming into Canada as received from foreign connections and freight crossing into the United States as freight delivered to foreign connections. Freight delivered to foreign connections includes exports from Canada and also in-transit freight which has been received from foreign connections, rail and water, destined to foreign points and which is shown in column 3. This in-transit traffic is heaviest between Detroit and St. Claire river gateways and the Niagara river gateways. There is also a considerable traffic from the western states through to Quebec ports and a lesser amount from the Pacific coast.

The line of increases over the corresponding month of the previous year which ran continuously from July, 1933, to December, 1934, was broken in January, 1935, when a decrease of 115,146 tons from January, 1934, was recorded. Decreases were again shown for March, May and August and the total of freight loaded at Canadian stations and received from foreign connections, amounting to 68,868,815 tons, was only 1,187,316 tons, or 1.8 per cent, above the 1934 total of 67,681,490 tons. Agricultural products were light throughout most of the year showing increases only in April, October and December and for the year were 925,705 tons below the 1934 total. Wheat shipments were light in Manitoba and Alberta but showed an increase of 367,984 tons, or 11.5 per cent, in Saskatchewan. Corn declined from 435,111 tons to 294,318 tons, the big decrease being in in-transit corn. Oats loaded at Canadian stations declined from 945,949 tons to 780,229 tons; barley, flour, hay and straw, cotton, apples, potatoes and other fresh fruit also declined. Animal products decreased from 2,440,637 tons in 1934 to 2,205,349 tons, all groups except cattle and calves, cheese, wool, hides and leather and other animal products showing decreases. Total loadings in this group increased by 44,316 tons, but imports decreased by 15,187 tons and in-transit freight by 264,417 tons. Mine products showed an increase from 23,714,200 tons to 24,180,576 tons. Anthracite and bituminous coal and coke all showed decreases, but lignite coal increased by 295,477 tons, or 12.9 per cent. Other ores and concentrates, base bullion, matte, pig and ingot, sand and gravel, slate, dimension or block stone, asphalt and other mine products all showed substantial increases. Forest products loaded and received from connections amounted to 8,019,329 tons as against 7,626,162 tons in 1934. Cordwood and firewood decreased, but logs, posts, etc., ties, pulpwood and lumber, timber, etc. all showed increases, the increase in this last group being 193,188 tons, or 6.8 per cent. Of the 25 commodity groups listed under manufactures and miscellaneous, 6 recorded decreases and 19 increases and the total of 18,757,815 tons was 1,488,766 tons over the 1934 total, made up of 532,765 tons increase in loadings, 96,749 tons in imports and 859,252 tons in in-transit freight. Automobiles, auto trucks and auto parts accounted for 345,149 tons of the increase, substantial increases being recorded in January and February and again in the last three months of the year, due probably to the new models being produced earlier than in former years. Iron and steel (bar, sheet, structural, pipe) also showed an increase of 241,511 tons and undoubtedly for the same reason this increase was built up largely in January, February and the last four months of the year. Agricultural implements increased from 104,303 tons to 150,101 tons and newsprint paper, other paper, paper board and wood pulp were all considerably heavier than in 1934.

On pages 24-27 are two tables, one for the three Maritime Provinces and one for the four western provinces. The net exports and imports from and to these areas are the differences between loadings and unloadings, but the net movement to and from other provinces is the difference between freight originated, including loadings and receipts from foreign connections, and freight terminated, including freight unloaded and delivered to foreign connections. If the freight originated in the Maritime Provinces exceeded the freight terminated the difference must have been carried westward, either for unloading in the other provinces or for delivery to foreign connections at a junction point in Quebec or provinces west. Also, if the terminated freight exceeded the originated, the difference came in across the Quebec boundary.

The export movement of wheat through the maritime ports continued heavy and 273,747 tons, or 9,122,900 bushels, were reported as delivered to foreign connections. The movement of corn was westward, being imported through maritime ports. Exports from the Maritime Provinces to other provinces of potatoes by rail declined from 286,448 tons in 1934 to 205,811 tons. Bituminous coal shipments also declined from 5,138,069 tons to 4,965,297 tons; most of this coal was shipped out by water as only 377,682 tons moved westward by rail, as against 4,529,926 tons unloaded and 57,689 tons

delivered to foreign connections. The westward shipments of newsprint paper increased from 47,696 tons in 1934 to 69,809 tons and of wood pulp from 27,276 tons to 38,054 tons.

Agricultural products loaded in the four western provinces decreased from 10,489,103 tons in 1934 to 10,004,603 tons, the largest decreases being barley 194,845 tons, oats 155,344 tons, and wheat 67,685 tons. The deliveries to foreign connections, which are largely through British Columbia ports, dropped from 2,011,096 tons to 1,887,424 tons, deliveries of wheat declining from 1,708,434 tons to 1,567,536 tons, or by 4,696,600 bushels. Loadings of cattle and calves increased from 277,152 tons to 340,428 tons but shipments of hogs declined from 125,048 tons to 112,377 tons. Loadings of bituminous coal declined by 224,449 tons, or 30 per cent, but lignite coal increased by 295,446 tons. Loadings of crude petroleum decreased from 15,739 tons to 4,274 tons, but asphalt increased from 9,537 tons to 31,007 tons. All forest product loadings showed good increases and the total of loadings and receipts from foreign connections increased from 2,600,442 tons to 2,882,834 tons. Most of this was unloaded and exported by water, the net eastward movement being only 244,817 tons. Cement loadings increased from 62,509 tons to 86,712 tons and brick and artificial stone from 26,247 tons to 36,252 tons. Shipments of fertilizers, which are largely commercial fertilizers from British Columbia, increased from 76,976 tons to 87,631 tons, the greater part of which was delivered to foreign connections. The net movement of newsprint paper from the eastern provinces amounted to 106,689 tons, most of which was for export. The eastward movement of fish was 10,000 tons as against a net westward movement from the eastern provinces of canned goods of 32,226 tons.
