YEAR ENDED DECEMBER 31, 1937

The data in the following tables include only revenue freight carried by the Canadian railways and not the "on company service" freight which includes coal for locomotives, ties, ballast and other railway material. These data will consequently not check with data on imports although this freight will not affect the exports. Freight interchanged between Canadian roads is not duplicated in these tables, but freight unloaded and subsequently reshipped is counted each time it is billed out. Foreign connections include railways in the United States and boats cleared for, or entered from, foreign ports, and in this report all freight moved to ports on export rates has been shown as delivered to foreign connections. Although the railways report all grain delivered to the elevators at the head of the lakes as unloaded at stations in Canada and all grain received from the lake elevators as loaded at billing stations the reports have been corrected from the elevator returns to show the deliveries to and receipts from foreign connections. Grain delivered to elevators at Montreal, Vancouver, and other ocean ports for export has been shown as delivered to foreign connections and adjustments have been made for grain taken out of these elevators for local consumption. Freight carried to ports on local rates has been reported as unloaded at stations although it might subsequently be exported by water routes. Grain unloaded at the elevators at the head of the lakes and later forwarded to Montreal by boat is reported as unloaded at stations in Ontario and does not again enter into the railway records, and consequently affects the net imports into the province. Also western grain ground in Ontario will increase the imports of grain since it is reported out as flour. Other provinces are similarly affected but to a less degree.

These data cover only railway revenue freight and the differences between column 1, "freight loaded," and column 6, "freight unloaded," are the net imports and exports by rail into and out of the respective provinces. If the loadings exceed the unloadings the data show a net export and if the unloadings exceed the loadings the excess is an import, irrespective of how often the same freight is loaded or unloaded. Except for freight handled by water, these data give a very complete picture of the movement of freight in Canada and, in the Prairie Provinces, where practically all freight is handled by rail, the net imports and exports cover all imports and exports into and out of these provinces.

A commodity may be imported and exported in another form such as wheat and flour, pulpwood and paper, etc., so that the net imports might be exported as other commodities.

Railways crossing the United States border consider their lines in the United States as foreign connections and show freight coming into Canada as received from foreign connections and freight crossing into the United States as freight delivered to foreign connections. Freight delivered to foreign connections includes exports from Canada and also in-transit

freight which has been received from foreign connections, rail and water, destined to foreign points and which is shown in column 3. This in-transit traffic is heaviest between Detroit and St. Claire river gateways and the Niagara river gateways. There is also a considerable traffic from the western states through to Quebec ports and a lesser amount from the Pacific coast.

Comparisons of freight loaded and received from foreign connections in one month with the same date for the corresponding month in the previous year have shown a continuous record of increases from September, 1935, to November, 1937, and December, 1937, showed a decrease from December, 1936, of only 101,704 tons, or 1.6 per cent. For the year 1937 the total freight carried amounted to 81,995,161 tons, an increase of 6,485,215 tons or 8.6 per cent over the 1936 traffic. Grain shipments were light, particularly wheat which decreased by 3,375,114 tons, or 66 per cent. This large decrease was mainly due to the small harvest in Saskatchewan where the tonnage decreased from 3,745,817 tons in 1936 to 1,007,546 tons, or by 73 per cent. Alberta wheat shipments declined by 440,931 tons, or 18 per cent, and Ontario shipments were lighter by 400,478 tons, or 32 per cent. These are largely reshipments of western wheat. Manitoba showed an increase of 180,980 tons, or 19 per cent. There was a heavy movement of hay and straw in the Prairie Provinces due to the necessity of moving feed to live stock in the drought areas. Shipments of coal - anthracite, bituminous and lignite - were 767,279 tons heavier than in 1936, other ores and concentrates jumped from 2,754,347 to 4,302,261 tons, mostly Ontario shipments, and sand and gravel and crushed stone showed increases of 830,369 tons and 732,992 tons respectively. These last two represented increases of 66 and 68 per cent. Forest products increased from 3,074,399 tons to 9,480,196 tons, pulpwood increasing by 656,574 tons, or 34 per cent, and lumber, timber, box, crate and cooperage material by 571,311 tons, or 17 per cent. All commodities listed under manufactures and miscellaneous showed increases ranging as high as 70 per cent. The larger increases were 447,256 tons in iron and steel, 235,022 tons in castings, machinery and boilers, 294,506 tons in automobiles and parts, 403,216 tons in newsprint paper, and 96,148 tons in wood pulp. The net increase in the group was 3,794,006 tons, or 18 per cent.

On pages 24-27 are two tables, one for the three Maritime Provinces and one for the four western provinces. The net exports and imports from and to these areas are the differences between loadings and unloadings, but the net movement to and from other provinces is the difference between freight originated, including loadings and receipts from foreign connections, and freight terminated, including freight unloaded and delivered to foreign connections. If the freight originated in the Maritime Provinces exceeded the freight terminated the difference must have been carried westward, either for unloading in the other provinces or for delivery to foreign connections at a junction point in Quebec or provinces west. Also, if the terminated freight exceeded the originated, the difference came in across the Quebec boundary.

PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND, NOVA SCOTIA AND NEW BRUNSWICK. - The export of wheat via the Maritime Provinces decreased from 374,983 tons in 1936 to 236,471 tons or by 29 per cent, or less than half the rate of decrease in all wheat shipments. Receipts of corn from foreign connections increased from 22,764 tons in 1936 to 67,502 tons and the westward movement of potatoes increased from 153,003 tons to 190,388 tons. Loadings of bituminous coal increased from 5,484,259 tons in 1936 to 5,891,813 tons; the bulk of this (5,288,768 tons) was unloaded for local use and forwarding by water, but the rail shipments westward increased from 397,654 tons to 520,335 tons. Sand and gravel shipments were influenced by road building and increased from 315,516 tons to 794,235 tons and asphalt loaded increased from 35,063 tons to 80,109 tons. Pulpwood loaded increased from 266,359 tons to 410,581 tons and exports from the area almost doubled. Shipments of iron and steel also almost doubled, increasing from 84,150 tons to 155,752 tons. Loadings of newsprint paper jumped from 33,294 tons in 1936 to 75,645 tons and paper board, pulpboard and wallboard increased from 47,267 tons to 65,873 tons. Total freight loaded and received from foreign connections in these three provinces increased from 9,241,132 tons to 11,029,468 tons, or by 19 per cent, and the freight unloaded and delivered to foreign connections increased from 9,459,755 tons to 10,961,761 tons, or by 16 per cent.

MANITOBA, SASKATCHEWAN, ALBERTA AND BRITISH COLUMBIA. - Total freight loaded and received from connections in the four western provinces decreased from 22,111,513 tons in 1936 to 20,410,017 tons, the big decrease being 2,984,332 tons of wheat loaded. Deliveries of wheat to foreign connections at western points dropped from 1,807,745 tons to 351,629 tons. Corn received from connections for Canadian points increased from 783 tons to 13,184 tons. There

were large decreases in loadings of flour and other mill products, but other fresh fruit, potatoes, and other fresh vegetables showed heavier loadings. Horses, cattle and calves, and sheep showed increased loadings, but hogs showed a decrease. Shipments of copper ore and concentrates amounted to 471,574 tons, as against only 512 tons in 1936, and other ores and concentrates loaded increased from 576,639 tons to 676,492 tons. Crude petroleum loadings jumped from 12,108 tons to 89,576 tons, but imports dropped from 475,987 tons to 321,545 tons. Loadings of cordwood and other firewood decreased 93,368 tons, or 13 per cent, but all other items of forest products showed substantial increases. Loadings of gasoline increased from 276,818 tons to 320,584 tons and imports were also heavier than in 1936, but petroleum oils and other products (except gasoline and asphalt) decreased slightly. Household goods and settlers' effects loaded increased from 24,595 tons to 53,426 tons, practically all of which was unloaded in the area, the net exports being only 5,911 tons. Newsprint paper loadings amounted to 97,706 tons, as against 62,817 tons in 1936, and the deliveries to foreign connections increased from 148,673 tons to 173,245 tons; shipments received from the eastern provinces amounted to 101,331 tons.

All weights quoted are in tons of 2,000 pounds.
