

S U M M A R Y
OF
MONTHLY RAILWAY TRAFFIC REPORTS
FOR
YEAR ENDED DECEMBER 31, 1938

The data in the following tables include only revenue freight carried by the Canadian railways and not the "on company service" freight which includes coal for locomotives, ties, ballast and other railway material. These data will consequently not check with data on imports although this freight will not affect the exports. Freight interchanged between Canadian roads is not duplicated in these tables, but freight unloaded and subsequently reshipped is counted each time it is billed out. Foreign connections include railways in the United States and boats cleared for, or entered from, foreign ports, and in this report all freight moved to ports on export rates has been shown as delivered to foreign connections. Although the railways report all grain delivered to the elevators at the head of the lakes as unloaded at stations in Canada and all grain received from the lake elevators as loaded at billing stations the reports have been corrected from the elevator returns to show the deliveries to and receipts from foreign connections. Grain delivered to elevators at Montreal, Vancouver, and other ocean ports for export has been shown as delivered to foreign connections and adjustments have been made for grain taken out of these elevators for local consumption. Freight carried to ports on local rates has been reported as unloaded at stations although it might subsequently be exported by water routes. Grain unloaded at the elevators at the head of the lakes and later forwarded to Montreal by boat is reported as unloaded at stations in Ontario and does not again enter into the railway records, and consequently affects the net imports into the province. Also western grain grown in Ontario will increase the imports of grain since it is reported out as flour. Other provinces are similarly affected but to a less degree.

These data cover only railway revenue freight and the differences between column 1, "freight loaded," and column 6, "freight unloaded," are the net imports and exports by rail into and out of the respective provinces. If the loadings exceed the unloadings the data show a net export and if the unloadings exceed the loadings the excess is an import, irrespective of how often the same freight is loaded or unloaded. Except for freight handled by water, these data give a very complete picture of the movement of freight in Canada and, in the Prairie Provinces, where practically all freight is handled by rail, the net imports and exports cover all imports and exports into and out of these provinces.

A commodity may be imported and exported in another form such as wheat and flour, pulpwood and paper, etc., so that the net imports might be exported as other commodities.

Railways crossing the United States border consider their lines in the United States as foreign connections and show freight coming into Canada as received from foreign connections and freight crossing into the United States as freight delivered to foreign connections. Freight delivered to foreign connections includes exports from Canada and also in-transit

freight which has been received from foreign connections, rail and water, destined to foreign points and which is shown in column 3. This in-transit traffic is heaviest between Detroit and St. Claire river gateways and the Niagara river gateways. There is also a considerable traffic from the western states through to Quebec ports and a lesser amount from the Pacific coast.

The decline in railway freight which started late in 1937 continued throughout 1938, only January and October showing heavier tonnages than for the corresponding months of the previous year. January's increase was due largely to heavy shipments of hay and straw, coal, ores and pulpwood, and October's increase was due to an increase of 1,597,722 tons or over 53,000,000 bushels of wheat and smaller increases in other grains more than offsetting decreases in the majority of other commodities.

The net result for the year was a decrease of 6,214,806 tons or 7.6 per cent despite an increase in agricultural products of 3,813,655 tons or 28 per cent. The large increase in wheat shipments of 3,432,580 tons or 67 per cent was due to a very light movement in 1937 more than a heavy movement in 1938, the latter being only slightly above the 1936 shipments. The heavy declines were in building materials such as sand and gravel, stone (crushed, ground and broken), lumber, iron and steel and in coal and manufactures. There also were large decreases in hay and straw, potatoes, cattle and calves, automobiles, newsprint and woodpulp. Shipments of copper ores and concentrates in British Columbia started in 1937 and rose in 1938 to 1,302,726 tons as against 471,574 tons in 1937, shipments in other provinces were small. Shipments of other ores and concentrates also increased from 4,302,261 tons to 4,446,668 tons. Ontario stations accounting for the major portion of this freight. Crude petroleum and gasoline also showed substantial increases.

On pages 24-27 are two tables, one for the three Maritime Provinces and one for the four western provinces. The net exports and imports from and to these areas are the differences between loadings and unloadings, but the net movement to and from other provinces is the difference between freight originated, including loadings and receipts from foreign connections and freight terminated, including freight unloaded and delivered to foreign connections. If the freight originated in the Maritime Provinces exceeded the freight terminated the difference must have been carried westward, either for unloading in the other provinces or for delivery to foreign connections at a junction point in Quebec or provinces west. Also, if the terminated freight exceeded the originated, the difference came in across the Quebec boundary.

PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND, NOVA SCOTIA AND NEW BRUNSWICK.— The export of wheat through Maritime ports decreased from 286,471 tons in 1937 to 142,515 tons, the lightest for several years. The net movement of corn was eastward, whereas in 1937 foreign corn was imported and moved west. The eastward movement of flour also decreased, but the net export of apples from the district increased from 86,416 tons to 97,512 tons. Net export of potatoes amounted to 182,817 tons, compared with 265,875 tons in 1937 and 237,503 tons in 1936. Bituminous coal loadings declined from 5,891,813 tons in 1937 to 4,930,660 tons, of which only 466,899 tons moved west by rail, the remainder of the exports being by water. The net movement eastward of base bullion, matte, pig and ingot (non-ferrous metals) increased from 92,135 tons to 122,608 tons. Loadings of pulpwood declined from 410,581 tons to 369,392 tons and of lumber, timber, box, crate and cooperage material from 707,261 tons to 504,813 tons. Sugar loadings increased from 86,432 tons in 1937 to 94,426 tons and the major portion of this moved westward by rail. Newsprint, other paper, paper board, pulpboard and wallboard (paper), and wood pulp all showed substantial decreases in loadings. The total freight loaded decreased, from 10,318,617 tons in 1937 to 8,316,455 tons and the net movement was 105,901 tons eastward, whereas in 1937 the net movement was 67,707 tons westward across the New Brunswick-Quebec boundary.

MANITOBA, SASKATCHEWAN, ALBERTA AND BRITISH COLUMBIA.— Compared with 1937 traffic, wheat shipments were particularly heavy increasing from 4,233,296 tons to 7,472,059 tons, loadings in Saskatchewan being almost two and a half times the 1937 loadings which were abnormally light. Other grains and agricultural products showed little net change and total agricultural products increased from 7,327,193 tons to 10,509,991 tons, or by 43.4 per cent. Animal products dropped from 954,118 tons in 1937 to 619,935 tons or by 35 per cent due to large decreases in live stock shipments, and smaller decreases in packing house products. Mine products increased from 6,391,622 tons to 7,190,392 tons despite a decrease of 261,364 tons in loadings of lignite coal and smaller

decreases in bituminous coal, crushed stone and several other items. The large increase in this group was copper ores and concentrates from 471,574 tons to 1,302,726 tons and crude petroleum from 89,576 tons loaded and 321,545 tons imported to 443,454 tons loaded and 51,015 tons imported. Other ores and concentrates and sand and gravel also showed substantial increases. Forest products tonnage amounted to 3,044,612 tons compared with 3,127,192 tons in 1937. Pulwood shipments were heavy for the first three months but fell off from 91,283 tons in January to 442 tons in September. The total, however, of 486,481 tons was an increase of 85 per cent over the 1937 total. In the manufactures and miscellaneous group there were a few large increases but the majority of commodities showed decreases and the total showed a net decrease from 2,812,337 tons to 2,389,284 tons, or by 15 per cent. Gasoline loadings increased by 92,147 tons and unloadings by 70,457 tons and the net imports decreased from 116,595 tons to 94,905 tons. Automobiles, trucks and parts unloaded increased from 70,555 tons in 1937 to 74,132 tons, but net imports declined from 60,586 tons to 55,508 tons. Net imports of agricultural implements and vehicles increased from 59,278 tons to 76,490 tons. Loadings of newsprint paper dropped from 97,706 tons to 46,890 tons and of woodpulp from 15,923 tons to 5,739 tons.
